TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Fiji Museum & Thurston Gardens** — The finest museum in the Pacific, housed in a colonial building inside the beautiful Thurston Gardens.
- **Colo-i-Suva Forest Park** — A cool rainforest reserve 11 km north of the city with marked trails, natural swimming holes, and waterfalls.
- **Suva Municipal Market** — One of the most vibrant markets in the South Pacific — produce, root vegetables, tropical fruit, kava roots, fresh...
- **Pacific Harbour & Arts Village** — About 45 km west of Suva, Pacific Harbour is known as the adventure capital of Fiji.
- **Colonial Suva Walking Tour** — Explore Suva's colonial heritage — the Grand Pacific Hotel (opened 1914, visited by royals), Government House, the Holy...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Fiji Museum** ~2 km · 1–1.5 hrs · easy — Walk the waterfront road from Kings Wharf past the seawall toward the city centre, then cut inland through Thurston Gardens to the...
- **Downtown Suva market loop** ~2.5 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — From the wharf, walk into the city grid to Suva Municipal Market for kava, tropical produce, and crafts.

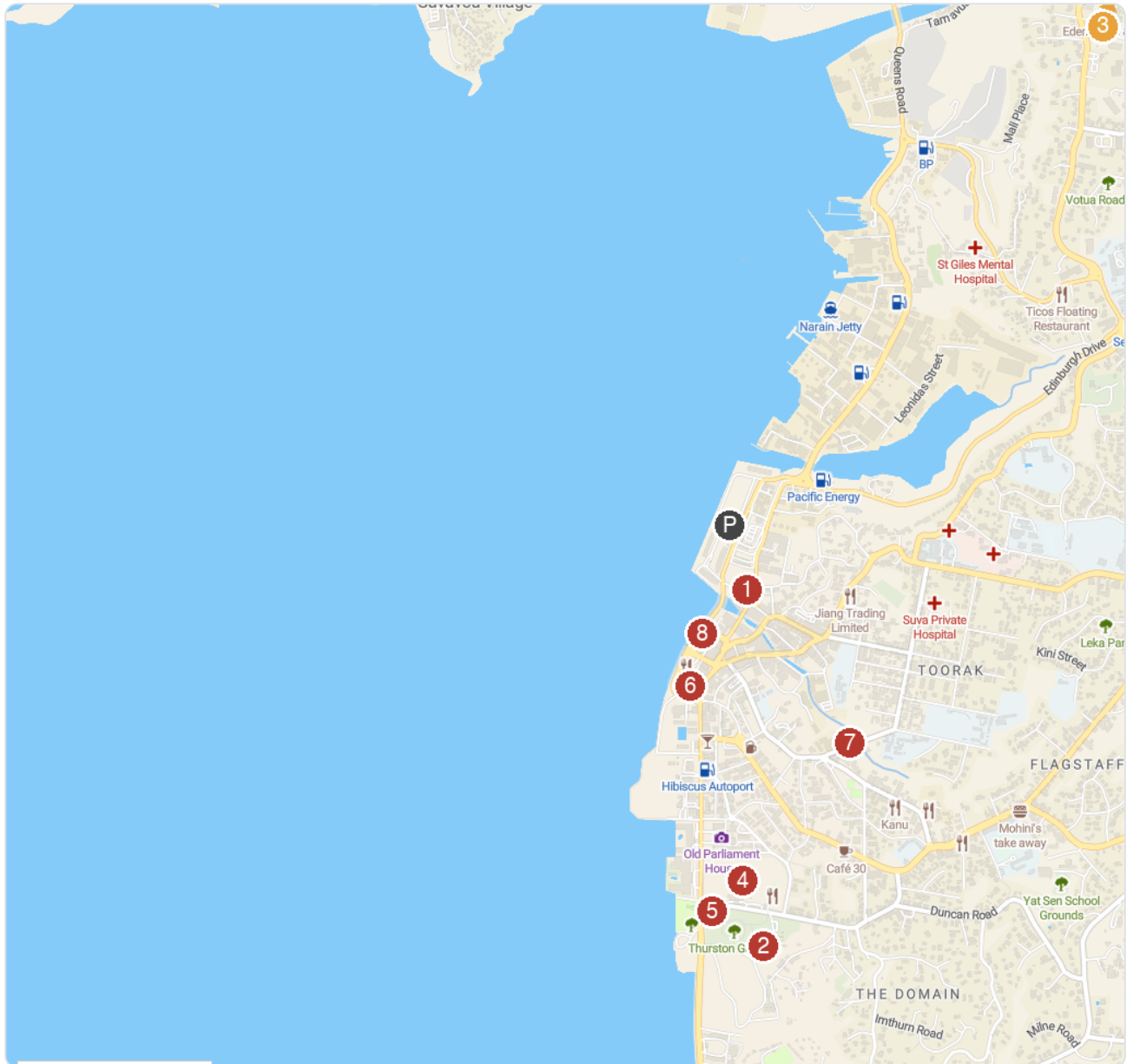
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pack a rain layer. Suva is the wettest capital city in the Pacific — short downpours are common year-round. A compact umbrella or light poncho is a must.
- Try kava. Fiji's ceremonial drink is sold in the market and offered on village tours. It's earthy and mildly numbing — say 'bula!' and drink the whole bilo in one go.
