GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Władysław IV Quay (Usedom side) for smaller ships; Ferry Terminal (Wolin side) for large ships

Walk to center: 5–10 min from Usedom quay; Wolin-side ships take free ferry across (~10 min)

Best For: Baltic beaches, Prussian military history, border-crossing cycling

Don't Miss: Stawa Młyny windmill beacon & cycling into Ahlbeck, Germany

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Stawa Młyny & West Breakwater Walk** — Stroll 1.5 km along the West Mole to the windmill-shaped navigation beacon at its tip — Świnoujście's iconic symbol.
- **Fort Gerhard & the Lighthouse** — On Wolin Island, Fort Gerhard is one of Europe's best-preserved 19th-century Prussian coastal forts with costumed guides.
- **Cycle to Germany** — Rent a bike at the port and pedal 6 km along a paved coastal cycle path into Germany — past the border arch to the...
- **Baltic Beach & Promenade** — Świnoujście's Blue Flag beach is up to 200 m wide with powdery white sand — among the finest on the Baltic.
- **Fort Anioła & Old Town** — Fort Anioła (Fort Angel) on Usedom is modelled on Rome's Castel Sant'Angelo, now housing an art gallery, a café in the...

BEST WALKS

- **City Centre to Beach via Spa Park** 2 km · 25 min · Easy · Free — From the quay, walk through Plac Wolności (city square), enter the historic Park Zdrojowy designed by Peter Lenné, follow the main...
- **Breakwater Walk to Stawa Młyny** 3 km round-trip · 40 min · Easy · Free — Head northwest from the port along the West Mole (Zachodnie Nabrzeże) to the tip, where the famous Stawa Młyny windmill beacon stands.

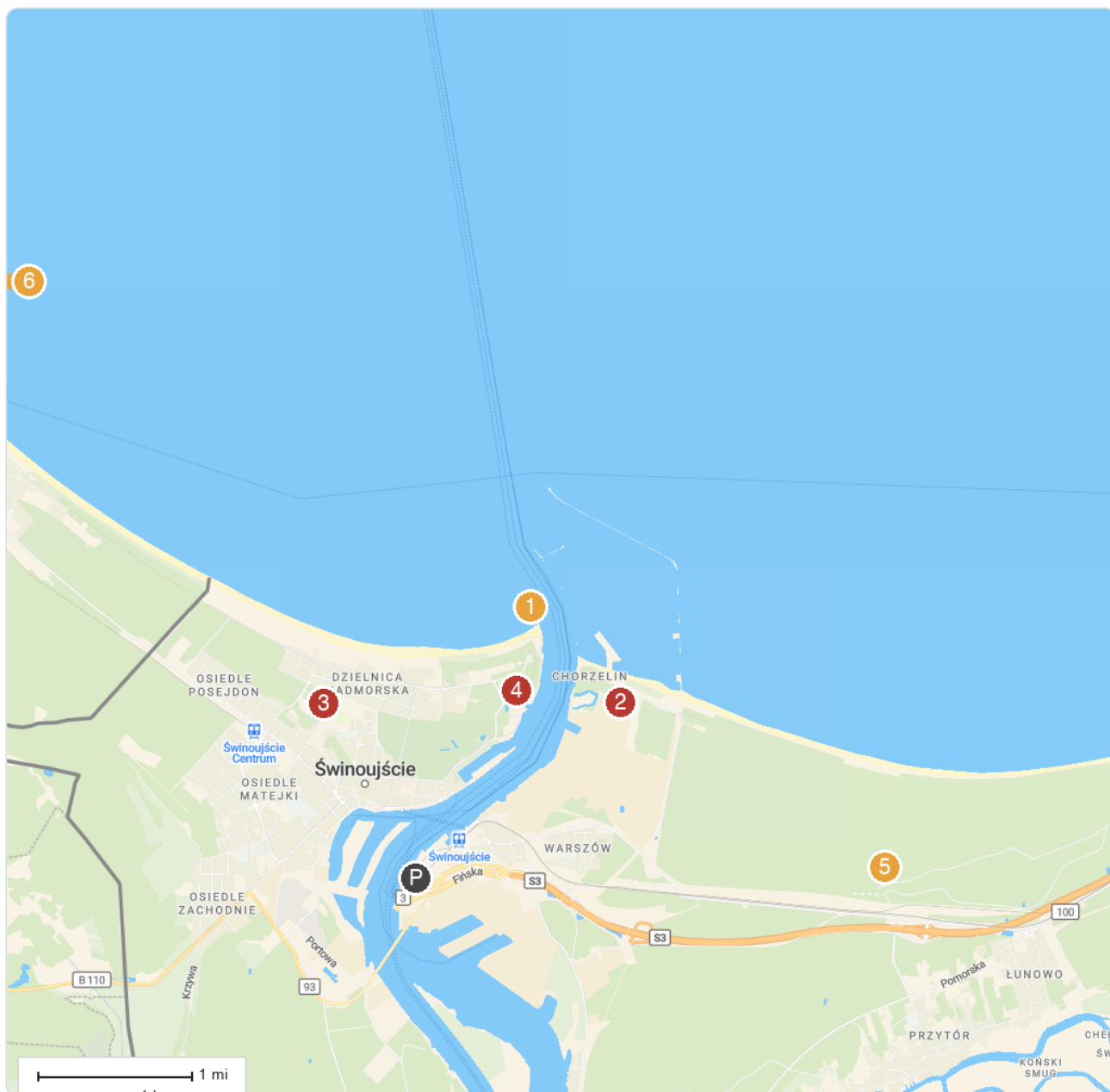
