GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — walk straight into Ermoupoli (no tender)

Walk to center: 5 min to Miaouli Square

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Miaouli Square & Neoclassical Ermoupoli** — Stroll the marble-paved Miaouli Square, admire Ernst Ziller's grand Town Hall, and wander the Vaporia district — the...
- **Ano Syros Medieval Quarter** — Taxi to the top and wander the 13th-century Catholic hill town: labyrinthine alleys, arched passages, and panoramic...
- **Apollo Theater** — A miniature La Scala built in 1864, Ermoupoli's Apollo Theater is a jaw-dropper.
- **Asteria Beach & Vaporia Swim** — Not sand — but the Asteria concrete lido platform in the Vaporia district offers crystal-clear deep water, loungers...
- **Galissas or Kini Beach** — Hop the KTEL bus (€2 each way, ~15–20 min) to Galissas — a sheltered sandy bay with calm water and tavernas — or Kini...

BEST WALKS

- **Harbour to Vaporia Loop** 3.5 km · 50 min · Easy — From the pier, walk to Miaouli Square, detour through the Apollo Theater, continue to St.
- **Ano Syros Descent** 1.5 km downhill · 25 min · Easy down — Take a taxi to the top gate (Kamara) of Ano Syros, wander the medieval alleys at your own pace, visit the Catholic Cathedral of Saint...

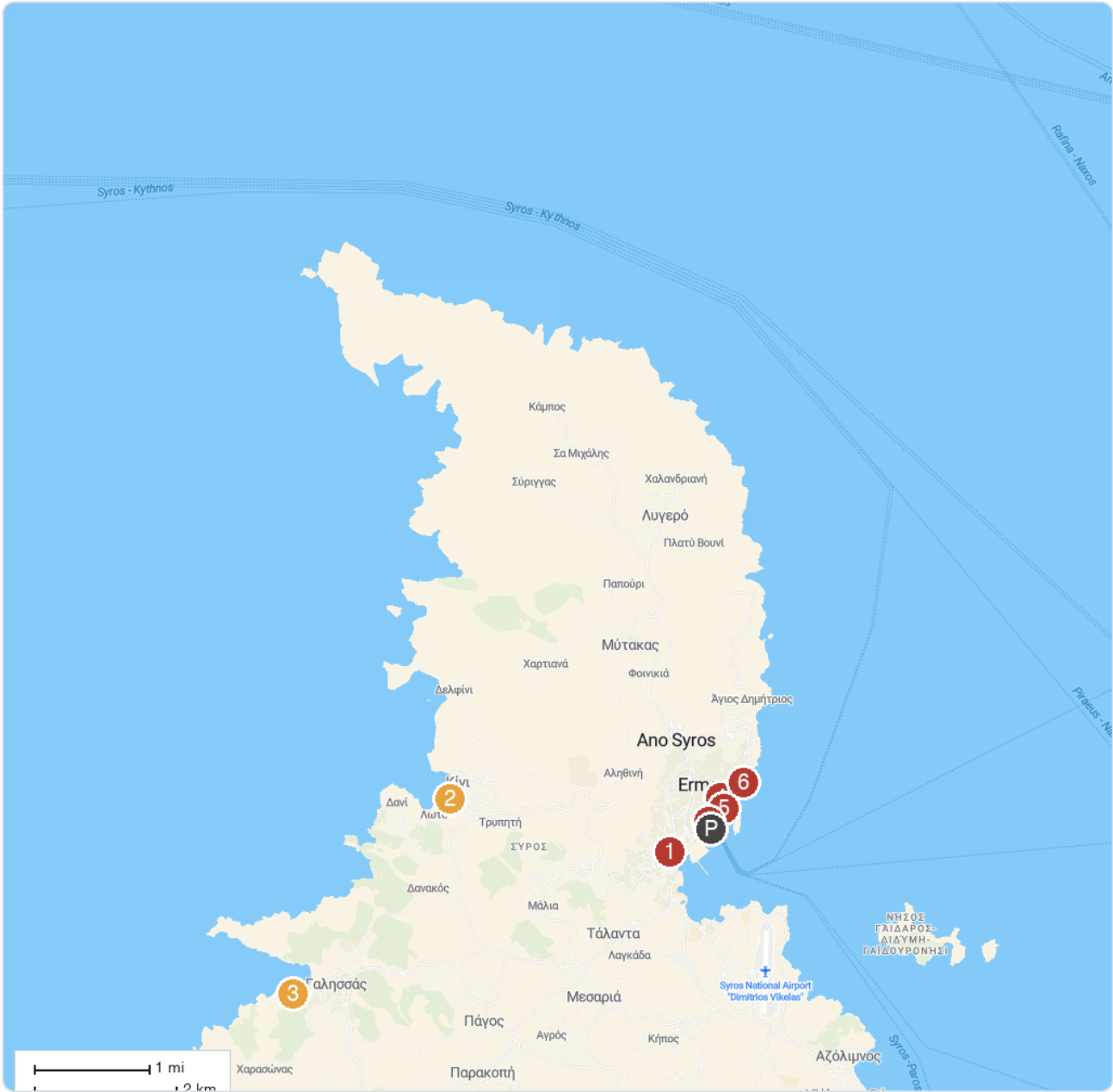
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Wear non-slip shoes. The marble paving in Ermoupoli and Ano Syros's stone steps are beautiful but can be treacherously slippery even when dry.
- Taxi up, walk down Ano Syros. Don't attempt the steep climb in summer heat — take a taxi to the top gate (€6–8) and walk the scenic downhill steps back to the port.
- Shop in the morning. Many back-alley shops close for siesta 2–5:30 PM. Waterfront cafes stay open but local boutiques don't.
