GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tokyo International Cruise Terminal (Odaiba) for large ships; Harumi Pier for smaller vessels; some itineraries dock at Yokohama (Osanbashi or Daikoku Pier)

Best For: Culture, food, temples, urban exploration, Yokohama Chinatown, Mount Fuji day trips

Walk to center: Train required — central Tokyo 20-30 min from Odaiba; Yokohama city center walkable from Osanbashi in 10-20 min

Don't Miss: Senso-ji Temple at dawn, Tsukiji Outer Market breakfast, Shibuya Crossing at rush hour

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Senso-ji & Asakusa District** — Tokyo's oldest Buddhist temple (founded 645 AD) anchors the historic Asakusa district.
- **Shibuya Crossing & Shibuya Sky** — Stand at the world's busiest pedestrian crossing where up to 3,000 people cross simultaneously every signal change...
- **Tsukiji Outer Market & Sushi Breakfast** — The world-famous Tsukiji inner wholesale market relocated to Toyosu, but the outer market remains a vibrant food street...
- **Meiji Jingu Shrine & Harajuku** — A vast forested Shinto shrine in the heart of the city, dedicated to Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken.
- **Mount Fuji & Hakone Day Trip** — Japan's iconic snow-capped volcano (3,776 m) is visible on clear days from Tokyo but fully experienced from Hakone — an...

BEST WALKS

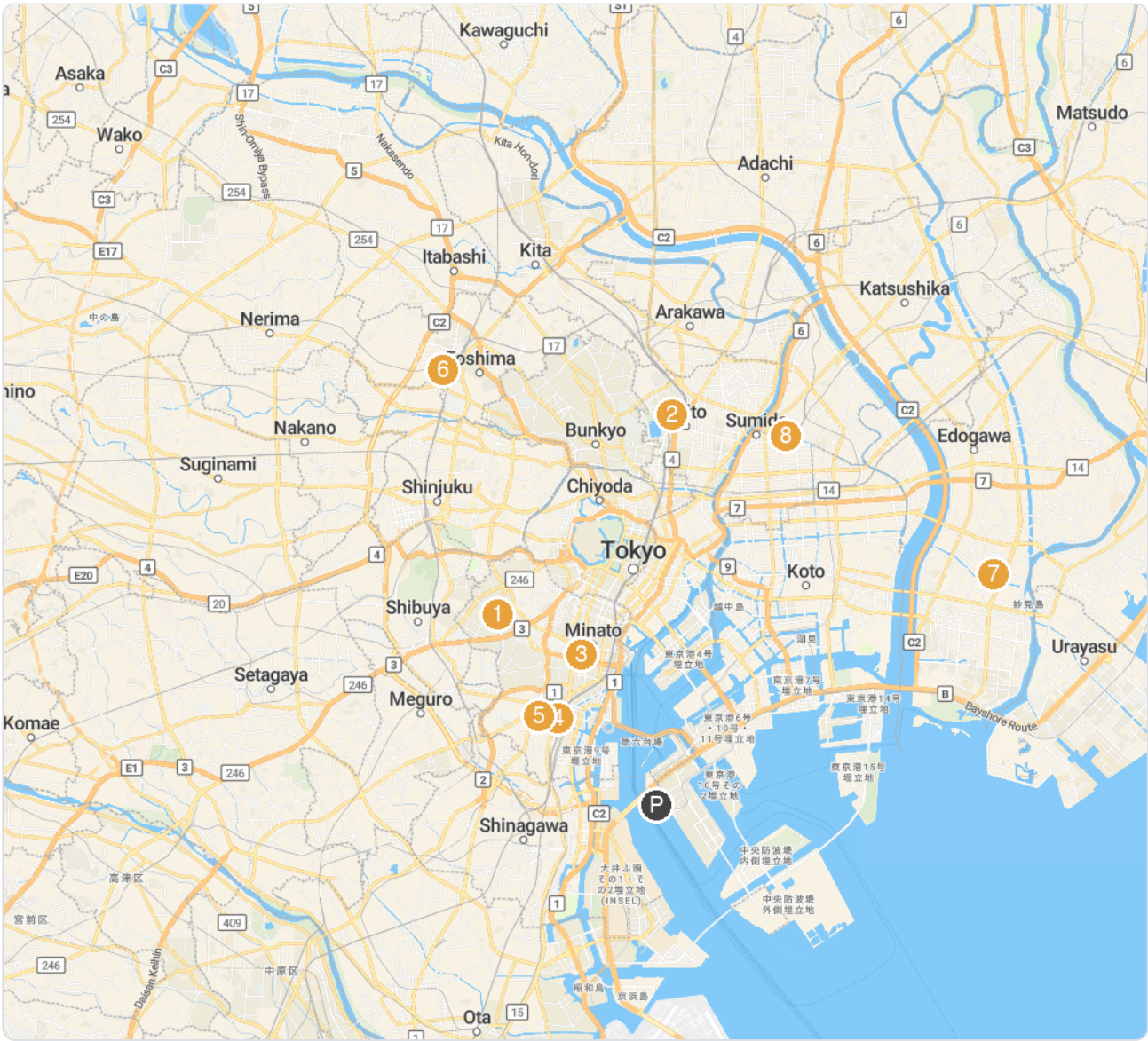
- **Odaiba Waterfront Stroll (from Tokyo Cruise Terminal)** Easy | 3-4 km | 45-60 min — A scenic promenade walk from the cruise terminal past teamLab Borderless (if open), the iconic Rainbow Bridge view, Odaiba Beach...
- **Asakusa Temple Walk (central Tokyo)** Easy | 2 km | 30 min walking + explore time — From Asakusa Station walk the Nakamise-dori shopping lane to Senso-ji Temple, then continue along the Sumida River embankment for...
- **Yokohama Waterfront Walk (from Osanbashi)** Easy | 2-3 km | 30-45 min — From Osanbashi pier, walk the harbor promenade past the Red Brick Warehouse (Aka Renga) with its cafes and craft shops, through the...

Aoyama Cemetery
Tokyo's historic public cemetery, final resting place for notable figures.

The National Museum of Western Art
Japan's premier museum showcasing Western art masterpieces.

Shiba Maruyama Kofun (Ancient tomb)
Tokyo's largest ancient burial mound, dating from the Kofun period.
- 4

Ruins of Takanawa Ōkido Gate
Historic stone remnants of an Edo-period city gate.
- 5

Site of the seppuku (ritualistic execution) of Oishi Yoshitaka and the other 16 Akougishi (Akou Roshi) samurai
Historic site of the 47 Ronin samurai's ritualistic execution.

Toshima City Agariyashiki Park
A tranquil city park with a historic residence and garden.
- 7

Furukawa Water Park
A scenic park featuring a large pond and walking paths.

Tokyo Skytree
A towering broadcasting and observation tower with panoramic city views.
