

Tórshavn, Faroe Islands, Denmark

One of the world's smallest capitals, Tórshavn is a storybook cluster of turf-roofed Viking houses perched on a North Atlantic harbor — where the parliament has met since the 9th century and 80,000 sheep outnumber the people.

GETTING ASHORE

Don't Miss: Tinganes old town peninsula and Kirkjubøur medieval ruins

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Kirkjubøur: Faroe Islands' Historic Heart** — A 20-minute drive south, Kirkjubøur holds the ruins of a 13th-century Gothic cathedral, a still-active medieval church...
- Vestmanna Sea Cliffs Boat Tour** — Cruise through sea caves and alongside 480 m basalt cliffs teeming with guillemots, kittiwakes, and puffins on this...
- Island Highlights: Fossá Waterfall & Saksun** — Drive north on Streymoy to visit Fossá — one of the Faroes' tallest waterfalls — then continue to Saksun, a remote...
- Puffin & Birdwatching Boat Around Nólsoy** — A 2-hour boat trip circles the island of Nólsoy — home to one of the world's largest puffin colonies — giving close-up...
- Tórshavn Old Town Self-Guided Walk** — Explore Tinganes, the turf-roofed government peninsula, the Á Reyni residential quarter, Skansin Fort, and the harbor...

BEST WALKS

- Harbor Loop: Tinganes, Skansin & the Waterfront** 1.5-2 hrs · Easy · Free — Start at Skansabryggjan pier, visit Skansin Fort for harbor views, continue along Vágshotnur waterfront past cafes and the harbor...
- Cathedral, Park & Art Museum** 1-1.5 hrs · Easy · Some paid entry — Walk up from the harbor to Tórshavn Cathedral (1788), continue to Viðarlundin city park for a peaceful stroll among one of the only...

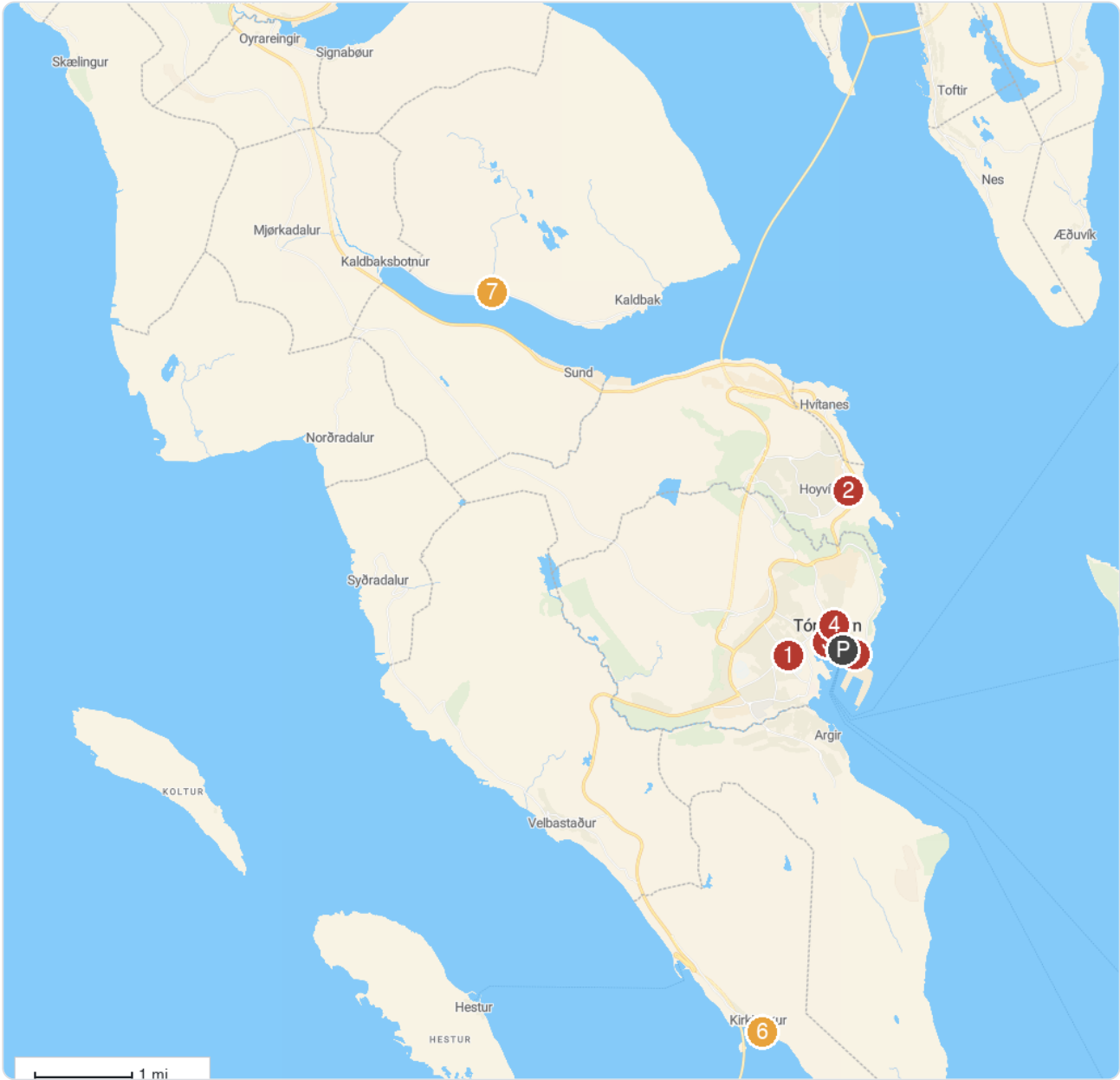
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
