TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Hospoda U Taterů — Legendary Tramp Pub** — A century-old pub in Staré Třebenice that has been the beating heart of Czech tramp culture — the tradition of weekend...
- **Vyhlička Máj — Panoramic Vltava Viewpoint** — A demanding but rewarding hike from Třebenice along the Třeblová valley to the Máj viewpoint, which looks down on the...
- **Slapy Dam & Reservoir Walk** — The Slapy Dam (1949–1955) is a major hydroelectric structure forming one of the Vltava Cascade's key reservoirs.
- **Riverside Relaxation & Swimming** — The Slapy Reservoir is a popular summer swimming destination for Czechs.

BEST WALKS

- **Pier to Hospoda U Taterů** ~0.8 km · 10 min · easy — A short walk uphill from the river landing into Třebenice village, following the road to the tramp pub.
- **Towards Vyhlička Máj (partial)** ~4–5 km one-way · 1.5–2.5 hrs · moderate — From the landing, follow the Třeblová stream valley southeast into the forest toward the Máj Viewpoint.

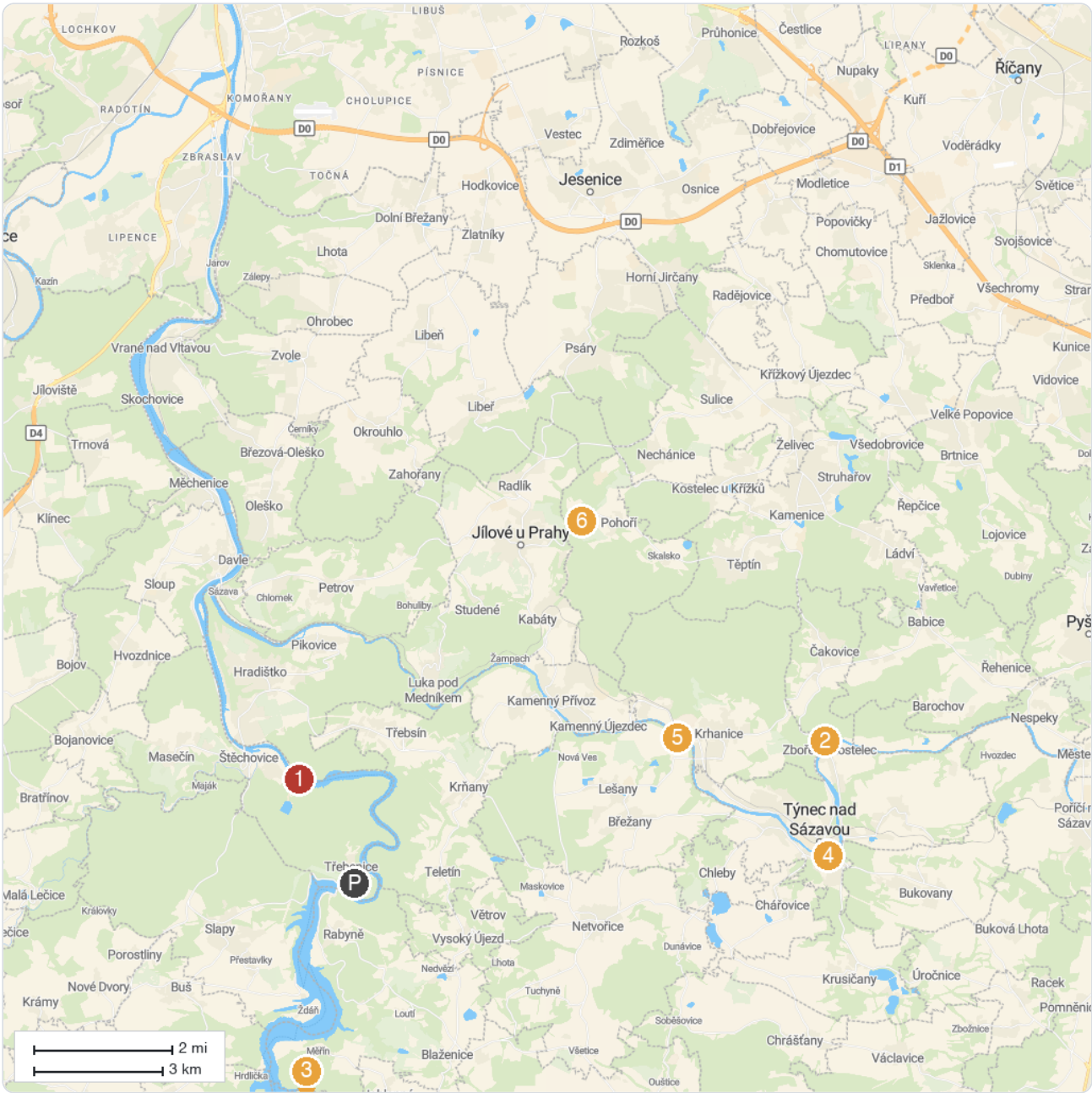
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cash only at the pub. Hospoda U Taterů operates on CZK cash. There are no ATMs at the landing or in the small village. Stock up in Prague before boarding.
- Short stop — stay near the boat. Lay-time at Třebenice is typically under 2.5 hours. The steamboat will leave on schedule. Set a phone alarm and stay within easy walking distance...
- Wear sturdy shoes. The forest paths to the viewpoint are steep, rocky, and can be muddy or icy depending on season. Flip-flops
