

Trier, Rhineland-Palatinate, Germany

Germany's oldest city wears two millennia lightly — Roman amphitheatres, imperial baths, and the iconic Porta Nigra all within easy walking distance of the Moselle quay. Add a glass of local Riesling at the Hauptmarkt and the afternoon practically plans itself.

GETTING ASHORE

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Porta Nigra & Roman Monuments Self-Tour** — Trier's defining landmark is the Porta Nigra, the best-preserved Roman city gate north of the Alps.
- **Constantine Basilica (Aula Palatina)** — The largest surviving intact Roman building outside Rome — once the throne room of Emperor Constantine, now a stunning...
- **Karl Marx House Museum** — The birthplace of Karl Marx now houses a thoughtful museum exploring his life, ideas, and global influence.
- **Hauptmarkt & Moselle Wine Tasting** — Trier's central market square is ringed by medieval buildings and café terraces.
- **Moselle Valley Vineyard Excursion** — The hills above Trier are terraced with steep Riesling vineyards.

BEST WALKS

- **Roman Trier Highlights Loop** 2.5 km · ~1.5 hrs · Easy · Flat — Start at the Porta Nigra, walk through the Hauptmarkt to the Cathedral and Liebfrauenkirche, continue to the Constantine Basilica and...
- **Amphitheatre & Karl Marx Walk** 2 km · ~1 hr · Easy — Head south from the centre to Trier's Roman Amphitheatre (holds 20,000), then loop back via Brückenstrasse and the Karl Marx House...

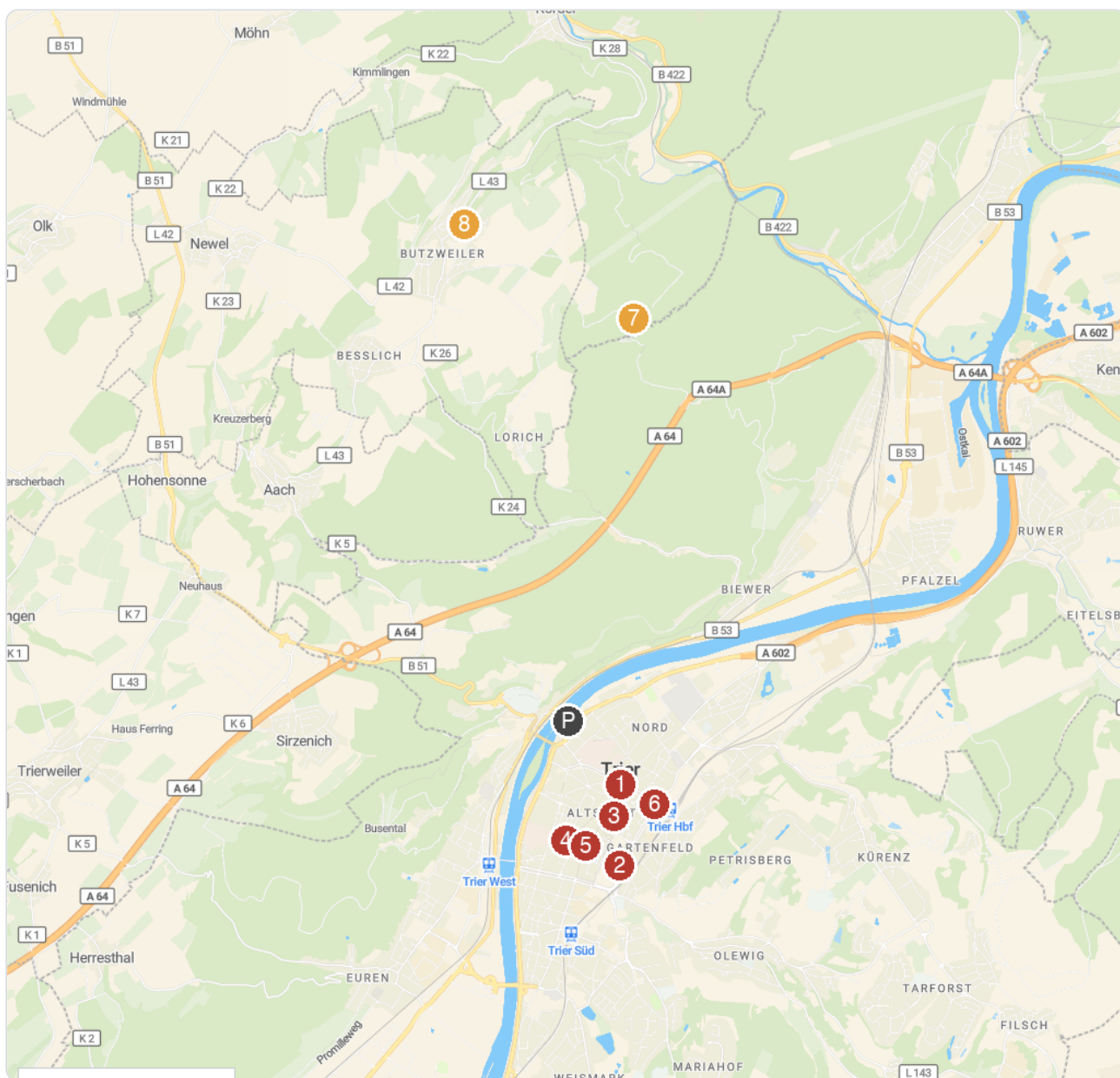
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Buy the combination ticket. The Trier Card or a multi-monument ticket covers Porta Nigra, Kaiserthermen, Amphitheatre, and Rheinisches Landesmuseum — much better value than paying...
Everything is walkable. All major Roman sites sit within a 1.5 km radius of the Hauptmarkt. Skip the tourist train unless your feet
