- Miramare Castle & Gardens** — Built for Archduke Maximilian of Austria in the 1850s, this white castle perches on a rocky promontory 8 km north of...
 - Grotta Gigante — Giant Show Cave** — A vast single-chamber show cave (former Guinness record-holder for largest tourist cave, 1995–2010), about 15 km from...
 - Ljubljana & Lake Bled (Slovenia)** — Cross into Slovenia for Slovenia's fairy-tale capital Ljubljana with its castle and café-lined river, then continue to...
- Postojna Cave & Predjama Castle (Slovenia)** — Explore Postojna's 24 km of caverns by electric train, then visit Predjama Castle — a medieval fortress built into a...
 - Trieste City Highlights Walk** — Piazza Unità d'Italia, the Roman Theatre, Canal Grande with its Joyce statue, Castle and Cathedral of San Giusto, and a...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront to San Giusto Hill** 2.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy–Moderate (hill climb at end) — From the Stazione Marittima, stroll along the waterfront past Molo Audace to Piazza Unità d'Italia, then wind through the Roman...
- Canal Grande & Coffee House Circuit** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — Head inland from the pier to Canal Grande, spot the James Joyce statue, explore the colonnaded streets of the Borgo Teresiano quarter...

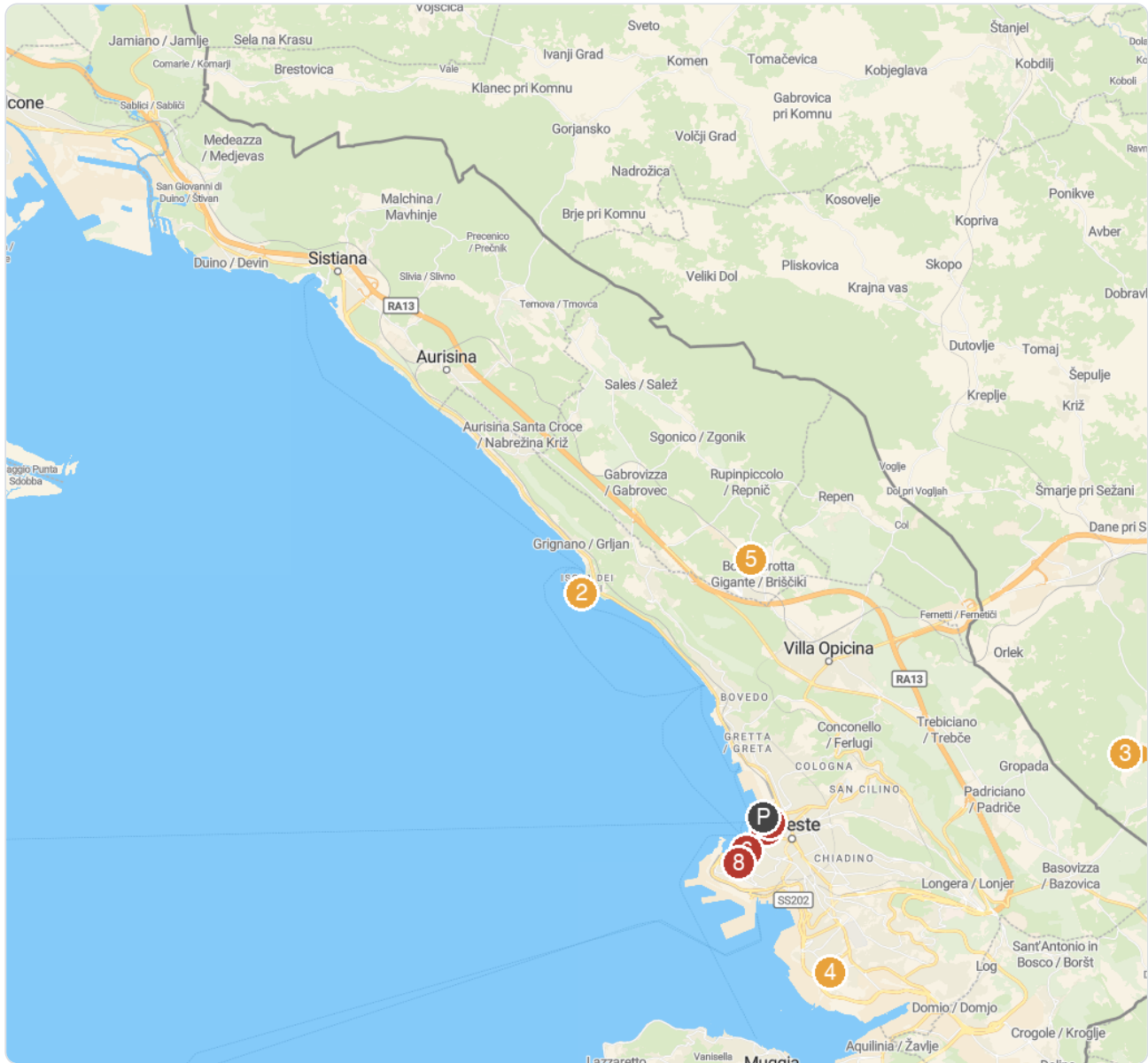
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
