GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small ships berth on the Riva (0-min walk); larger ships tender to same dock or call Split

Best For: Medieval architecture, Game of Thrones fans, leisurely Old Town wandering

Walk to Center: Instant — gangway puts you on the Riva promenade

Don't Miss: Climbing St. Lawrence Cathedral's bell tower for 360° views of the islands

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **St. Lawrence Cathedral & Bell Tower Climb** — Trogir's UNESCO centerpiece features Radovan's Portal — one of the finest Romanesque stone carvings in the Adriatic...
- **Old Town Walking Tour — Alleyways & Squares** — Wander the maze of shiny limestone lanes past Gothic balconies, hidden courtyards, the City Loggia, the Land Gate with...
- **Kamerlengo Castle** — A 15th-century Venetian fortress at the tip of the island, with walkable ramparts and sweeping views over the sea.
- **Okrug Gornji Beach, Čiovo Island** — A 2 km pebble stretch across the bridge on Čiovo island, lined with beach bars and water-sports rentals.
- **Day Trip to Split** — Trogir sits 30 km from Split, making a combined visit easy.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Complete Loop** 1.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy — From the Riva promenade, enter through the Land Gate, cross the main square past the Cathedral and City Loggia, wind through the alley...

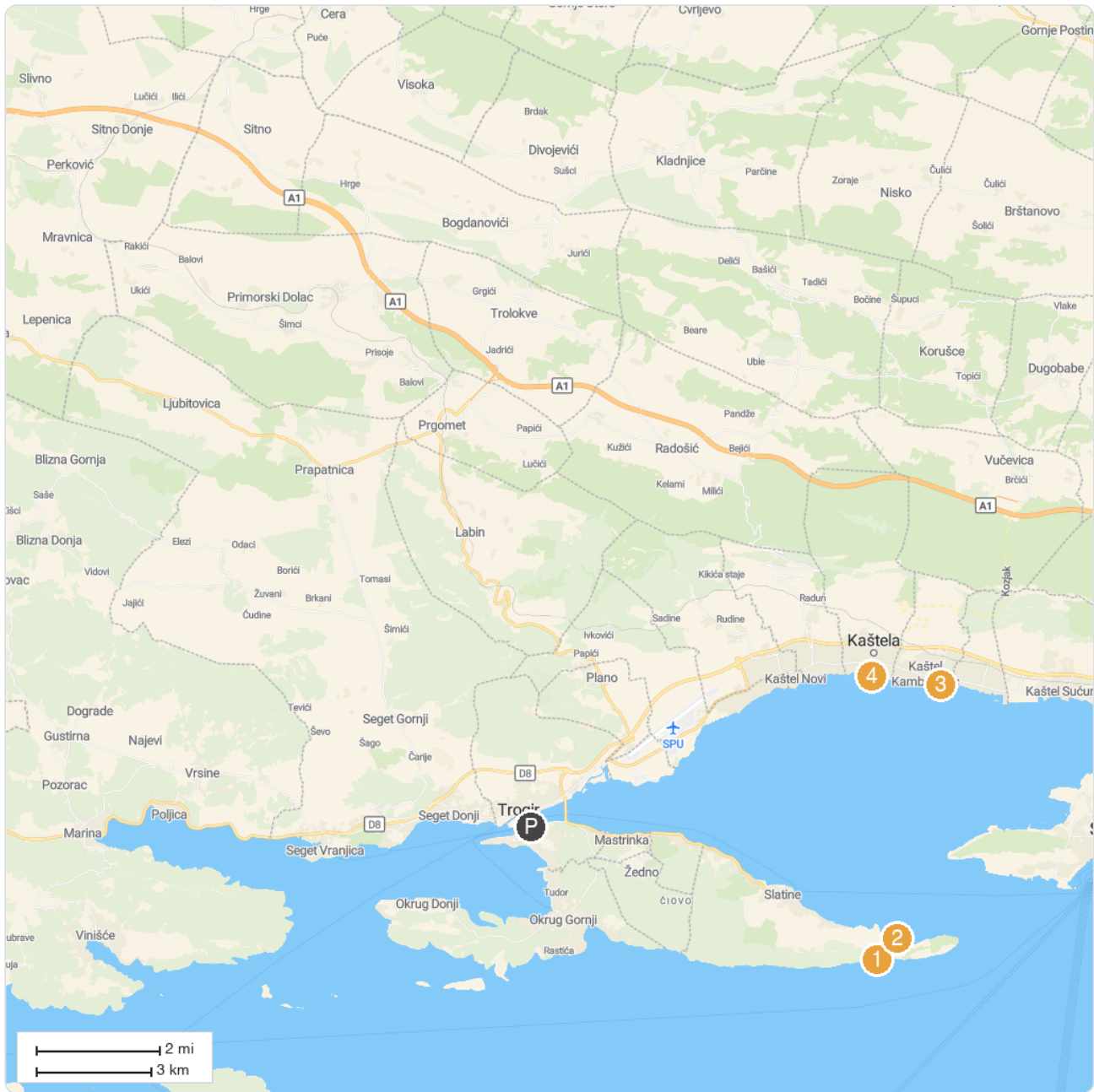
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry some cash. Euros are the currency. Cards work at most restaurants and shops, but taxi boats, small bakeries, and entry
