TOP THINGS TO DO

- RIB Safari into Trollfjord** — Departs from Svolvær harbour.
- Sea Eagle Safari** — Boat captains carry fish to hand-feed white-tailed sea eagles — Europe's largest bird of prey — right alongside the boat.
- Silent Electric Cruise** — Operated by Brim Explorer from Svolvær, these quiet electric vessels glide into the fjord with minimal impact — ideal...
- Kayaking Inside the Fjord** — Some expedition ship programmes offer guided sea kayak tours inside Trollfjord's glassy water.

- Deck Circuit — Best Photo Positions** Onboard | 5 min | All abilities — Walk the full circuit of your ship's open decks before entering.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Dress in full winter layers regardless of season. The fjord is deeply shaded, winds funnel between the walls, and temperatures feel 5–10°C colder than the open sea. Windproof...
- Bring both wide-angle and zoom lenses. A wide lens captures the impossible scale of the cliffs; a zoom lets you pull in the sea eagles soaring hundreds of metres above.
- Scan the cliff tops for white-tailed sea eagles — wingspan up to 2.4m. They nest in the crags and frequently soar low over passing ships. Look for the distinctive wedge-shaped...
