TOP THINGS TO DO

- Nidaros Cathedral & Archbishop's Palace** — The crown jewel of Trondheim and the northernmost medieval cathedral in the world, built over the tomb of St.
- Munkholmen Island** — A short 15-minute ferry from Ravnkloa fish market takes you to this small island in the fjord — once a Benedictine...
- Kristiansten Fortress** — Built in 1681 after a devastating fire, this hilltop fortress east of the city saved Trondheim from Swedish capture in...
- Ringve Music Museum & Rockheim** — Combine two of Norway's finest music museums in one day.

BEST WALKS

- Cathedral Quarter & Gamle Bybro Loop** ~2.5 km · 1.5–2 hrs · easy — From the pier, walk to the magnificent Nidaros Cathedral and explore the Archbishop's Palace, then cross the iconic red Gamle Bybro...
- Bakklandet & the Trampe Bike Lift** ~2 km · 1–1.5 hrs · easy — Stroll the charming cobblestone lanes of Bakklandet, lined with wooden houses turned cafés and boutiques.
- Stiftsgården & City Centre Stroll** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — Explore Torvet (the main square) and visit Stiftsgården, the royal residence and one of Scandinavia's largest wooden buildings.

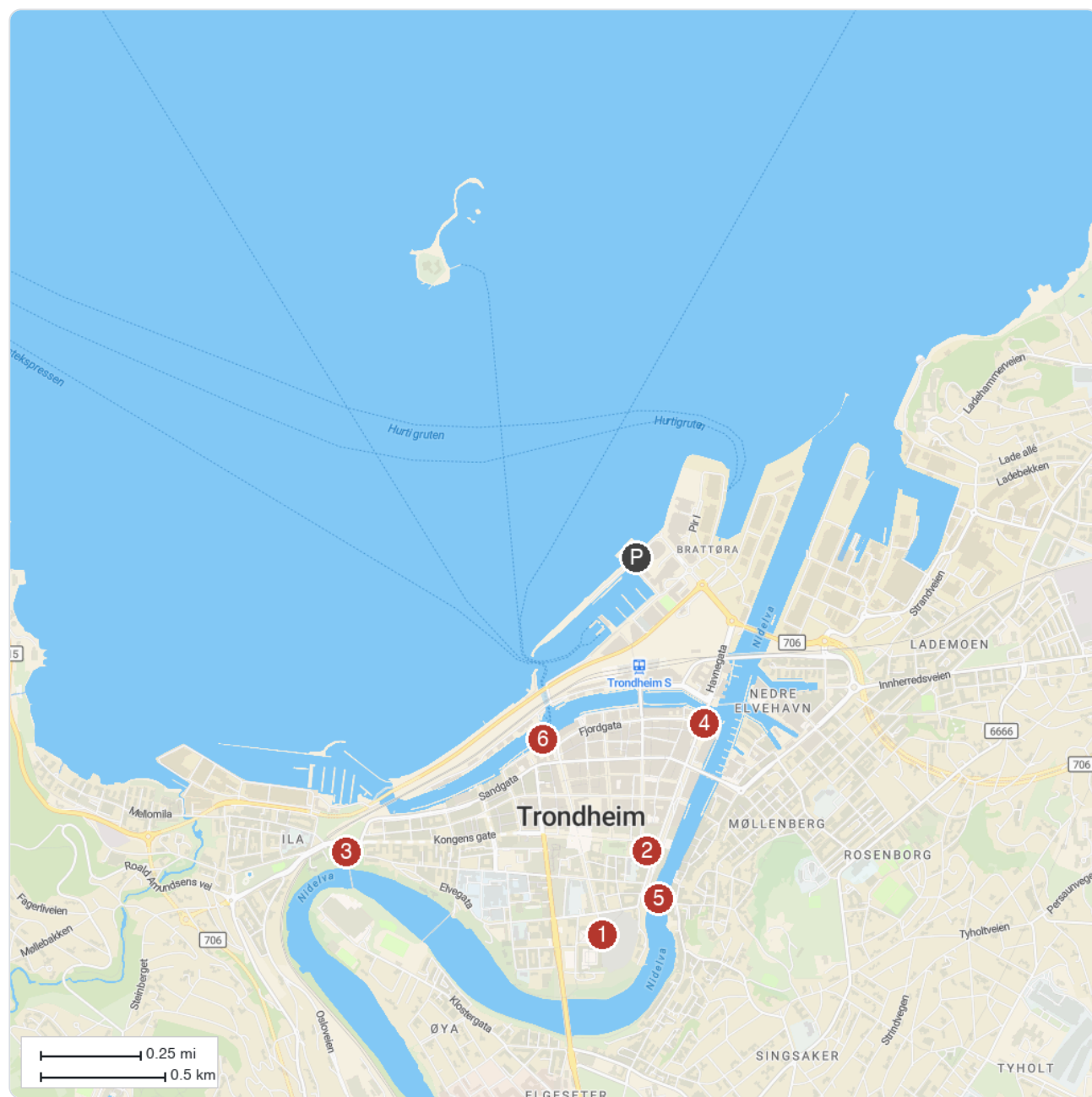
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
