GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Riverside quay — ships berth directly on the Faleza promenade; no tender

Best For: Delta boat tours, birdwatching, fresh fish, Romanian history

Walk to center: 0–5 min flat walk to Civic Square and promenade cafés

Don't Miss: Small-boat excursion into the Danube Delta channels to spot Great White Pelicans

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Danube Delta Small-Boat Tour** — Glide through narrow reed-lined channels into the UNESCO Danube Delta — Europe's second-largest river delta.
- **Independence Monument & Aegyssus Ruins** — Climb Monument Hill to the 1877 Independence Monument obelisk for panoramic views over the Danube and your ship far...
- **Danube Delta Ecomuseum** — One of Europe's finest Delta museums, with a living aquarium of Danube fish including massive sturgeons, interactive...
- **Promenade Fish Lunch** — Dobrogea cuisine is built on freshwater fish.
- **Ciuperca Lake Beach** — Tulcea has no sea beach, but Ciuperca Lake on the city's western edge offers a freshwater sandy beach with lounge...

BEST WALKS

- **Promenade to Civic Square** Flat • 10 min • Free — A gentle stroll from the ship along Faleza Tulcea past riverside cafés to Piața Civică, dominated by the equestrian statue of Mircea...
- **Monument Hill Loop** Moderate • 1–1.5 hrs • Free — From Civic Square, follow the signs uphill to the Independence Monument obelisk and the Aegyssus fortress ruins.
