TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Beagle Channel Catamaran Cruise** — Sail the channel Darwin charted, past sea lion colonies, cormorant rookeries, and the iconic Les Éclaireurs Lighthouse...
- **Tierra del Fuego National Park** — Sub-Antarctic forest, peat bogs, Lapataia Bay, and the marker where the Pan-American Highway ends.
- **End of the World Train (Tren del Fin del Mundo)** — A narrow-gauge heritage steam railway that retraces the route prisoners once rode to fell timber.
- **Catamaran to Gable Island & Penguin Colony** — A longer channel trip out to a Magellanic (and sometimes Gentoo) penguin rookery, often with a walk on Gable Island and...

BEST WALKS

- **San Martín street & the waterfront** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — Stroll the main drag for outdoor gear, chocolate, and king-crab restaurants, then loop back along the Costanera waterfront with Beagle...
- **Glaciar Martial trail** ~5 km round-trip · 2.5–3 hrs · moderate–strenuous — A steep climb above town to the Martial Glacier cirque, with sweeping views over the city, channel, and mountains.
- **Museo Marítimo & ex-Presidio** ~1 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — The former end-of-the-world prison, now a museum of Antarctic exploration, maritime history, and the penal colony that built the town.

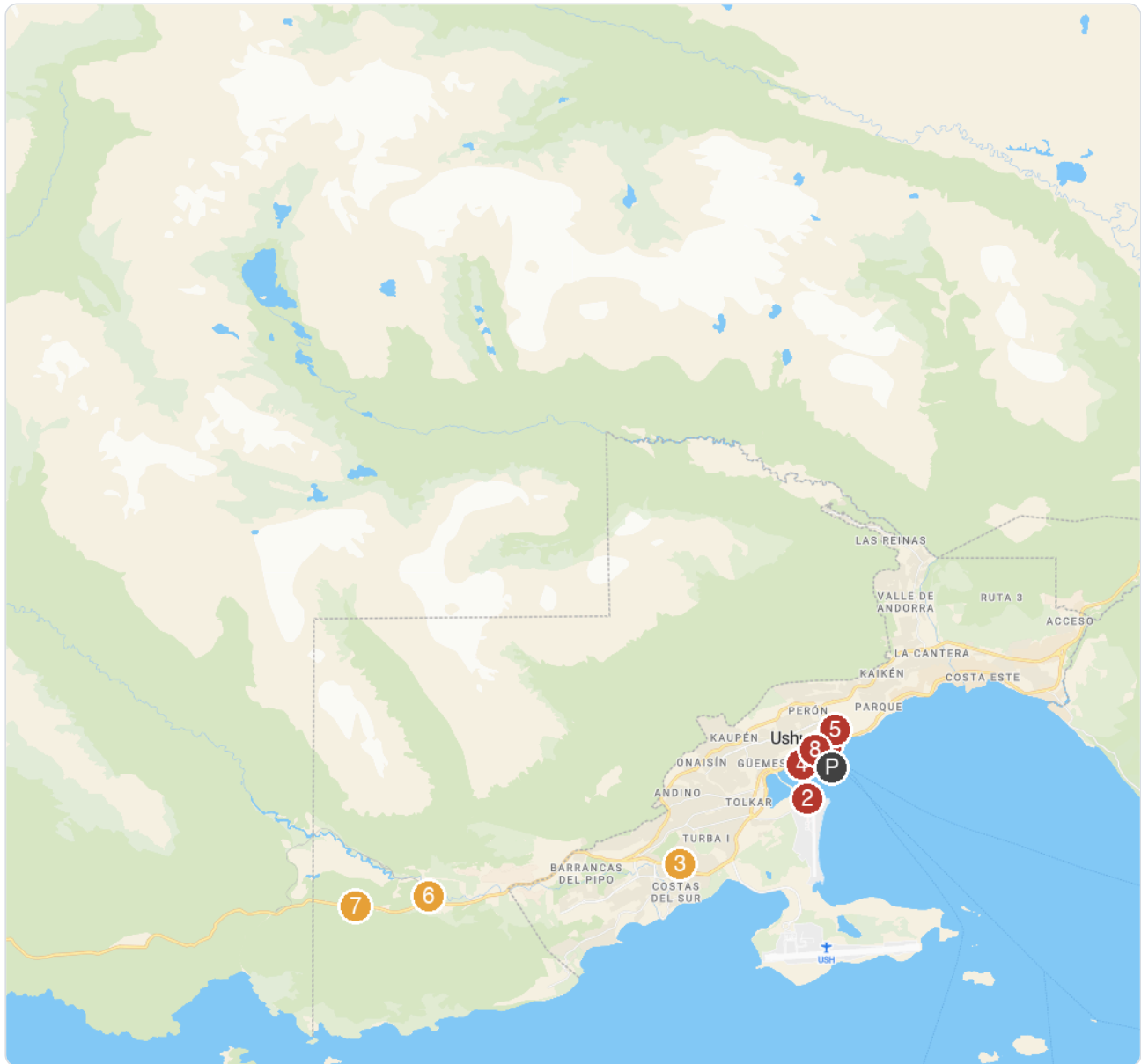
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Eat the centolla (king crab). Ushuaia is one of the best places on Earth for it — a fresh king-crab lunch on San Martín is practically mandatory.
- Layer up, even in summer. Weather here turns fast — sun, wind, and rain in one afternoon. A waterproof shell and warm mid-layer are essential year-round.
