GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside river quay (Amsterdam-Rhine Canal area) — no tender

Walk to center: ~1.5–2.5 km (20–30 min flat walk) or short taxi/bus

Best For: Medieval history, canal-side dining, architecture, day-trippers

Don't Miss: Climbing the Dom Tower & exploring DOMunder beneath Dom Square

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Climb the Dom Tower** — At 112 m, the Dom Tower is the tallest church tower in the Netherlands.
- **DOMunder Archaeological Tour** — Armed with a flashlight, descend beneath Dom Square to explore two millennia of Utrecht's history — Roman fortress...
- **Oudegracht Canal Walk & Wharf Cellars** — Utrecht's medieval canals are unique: the wharves sit a full level below street, and the arched cellar doors now house...
- **Museum Speelklok** — A medieval church packed with self-playing musical instruments — from ornate 18th-century music boxes to enormous...
- **City Cycling Tour** — Utrecht is one of the world's great cycling cities — over 300 km of bike lanes and a culture built on two wheels.

BEST WALKS

- **Dom Square to the Old Canal** 1.5 km · 30–40 min · flat — Start at the iconic Dom Tower and Domkerk, duck into the peaceful Pandhof cloister garden, then follow Lange Nieuwstraat down to the...
- **Miffy Walk** 1 km · 20 min · flat — Pay tribute to Utrecht's most famous resident: find the Miffy traffic light at Lange Vliestraat, then walk to the Miffy Museum...

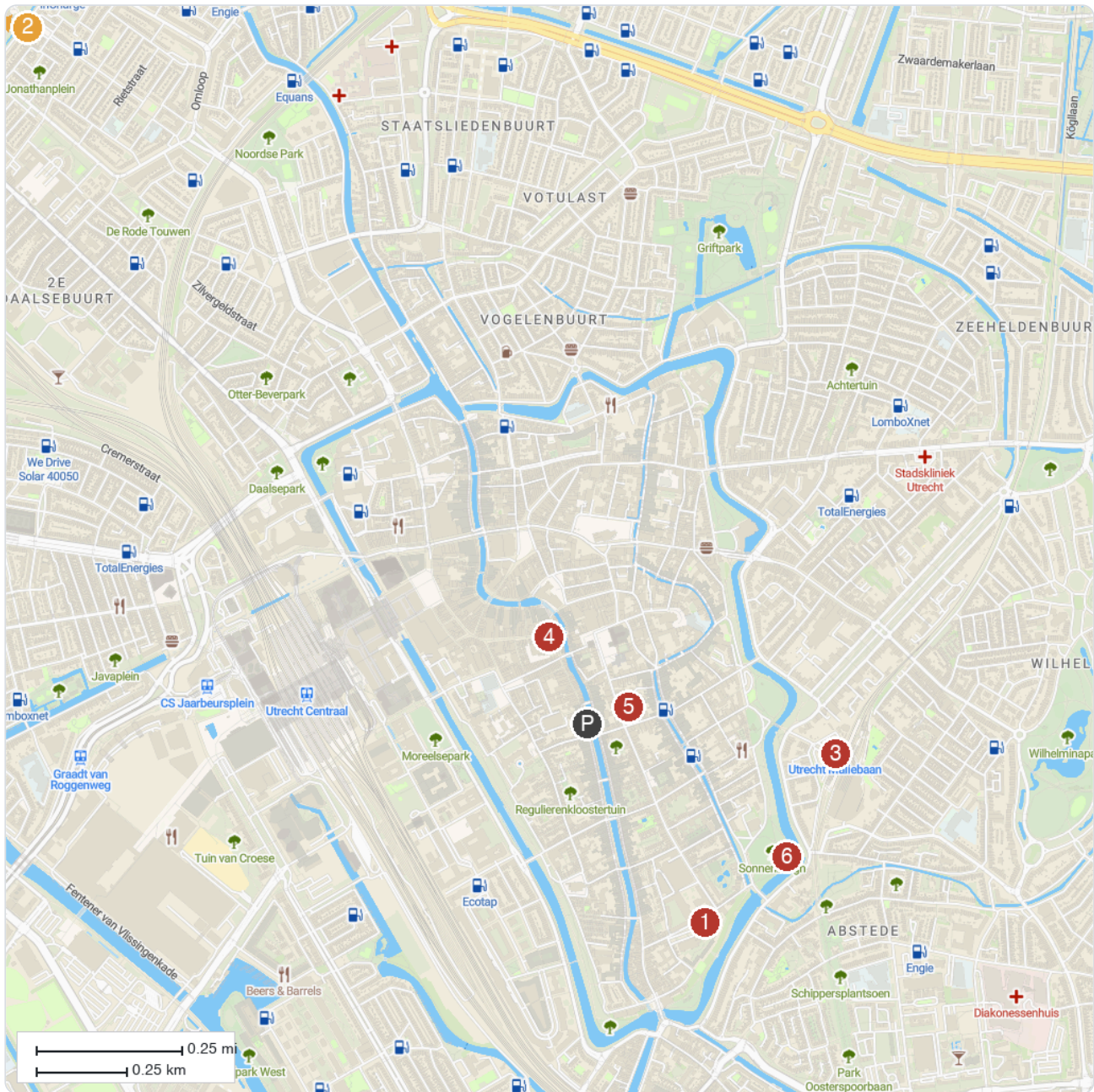
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
