- Cerro Alegre & Cerro Concepción Walking Tour** — Stroll the UNESCO-listed hillside neighborhoods where pastel houses, open-air murals, and café-lined lanes reward every...
 - La Sebastiana — Pablo Neruda's House** — The Nobel laureate's eccentrically decorated clifftop home is now a museum.
- Casablanca Valley Wine Tasting** — Chile's premier cool-climate wine zone sits just 30 minutes inland.
 - Santiago City Day Trip** — Chile's cosmopolitan capital rewards a long day: Plaza de Armas, La Moneda Palace, Mercado Central's seafood hall, and...
 - Cerro San Cristóbal Funicular, Santiago** — For those heading to Santiago, the 1925 funicular up Cerro San Cristóbal delivers panoramic city-and-Andes vistas.

BEST WALKS

- Muelle Prat to Cerro Alegre Loop** 2.5 km · 1.5-2 hrs · Moderate (steep ascents) — Start at Muelle Prat on the waterfront, cross Plaza Sotomayor, and take Ascensor El Peral up to Cerro Alegre.
- Waterfront & Fish Market Stroll** 1.5 km · 45 min · Easy (flat) — An easy flat walk along the Avenida Errázuriz waterfront from Muelle Prat past the sea lion colony at the fish market (Caleta Portales...

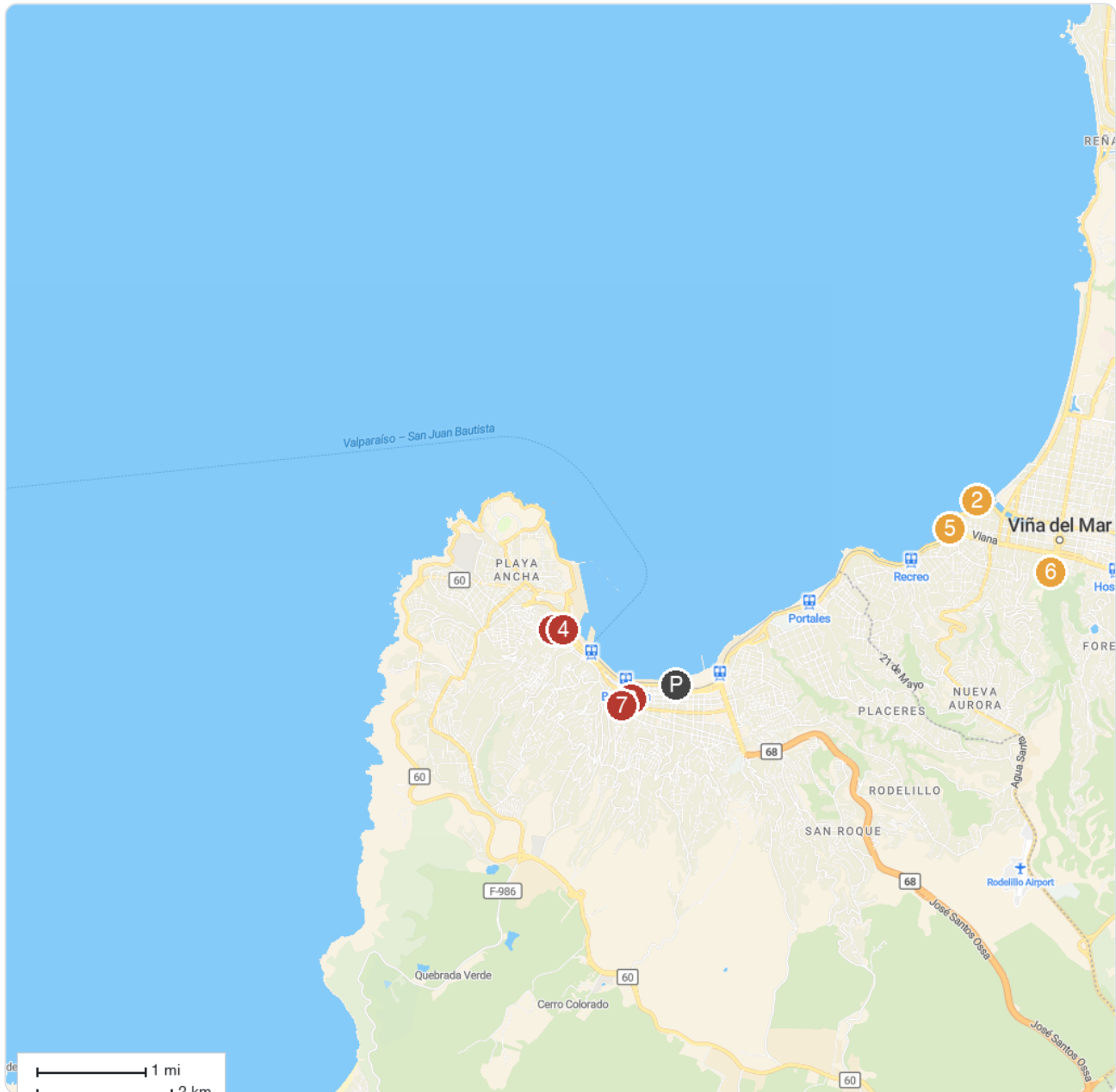
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Ride several ascensores — most cost about CLP 200–400 each way. Some are cash-only. Have small bills handy.
- Santiago day-trippers: leave early. The drive is 1.5–2 hrs each way; aim to depart port by 8 AM to get 4+ hrs in the capital.
