Docking: Canada Place terminal — downtown waterfront, 3 berths, no tender ever

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Stanley Park & Seawall** — Walk or cycle the 8.8 km paved seawall circling North America's largest urban park.
- **Capilano Suspension Bridge** — A 137-metre swaying bridge 70 metres above the Capilano River canyon in North Vancouver's old-growth forest.
- **Whistler Day Trip** — Canada's most celebrated mountain resort is 120 km north via the Sea-to-Sky Highway — consistently ranked one of the...
- **Granville Island Public Market** — A former industrial peninsula turned vibrant food and arts hub on False Creek.
- **Gastown Walking Tour** — Vancouver's oldest neighbourhood, 10 minutes on foot from Canada Place.

BEST WALKS

- **Coal Harbour Seawall to Stanley Park** 2.5 km · ~30 min · Easy · Flat paved path — Stroll west from Canada Place along the Coal Harbour waterfront past float-plane terminals, rows of superyachts, and the Rowing Club...
- **Gastown & Chinatown Loop** 3.5 km · ~50 min · Easy — Head east from Canada Place into historic Gastown — Water Street Steam Clock, Maple Tree Square, red brick warehouses — then south...

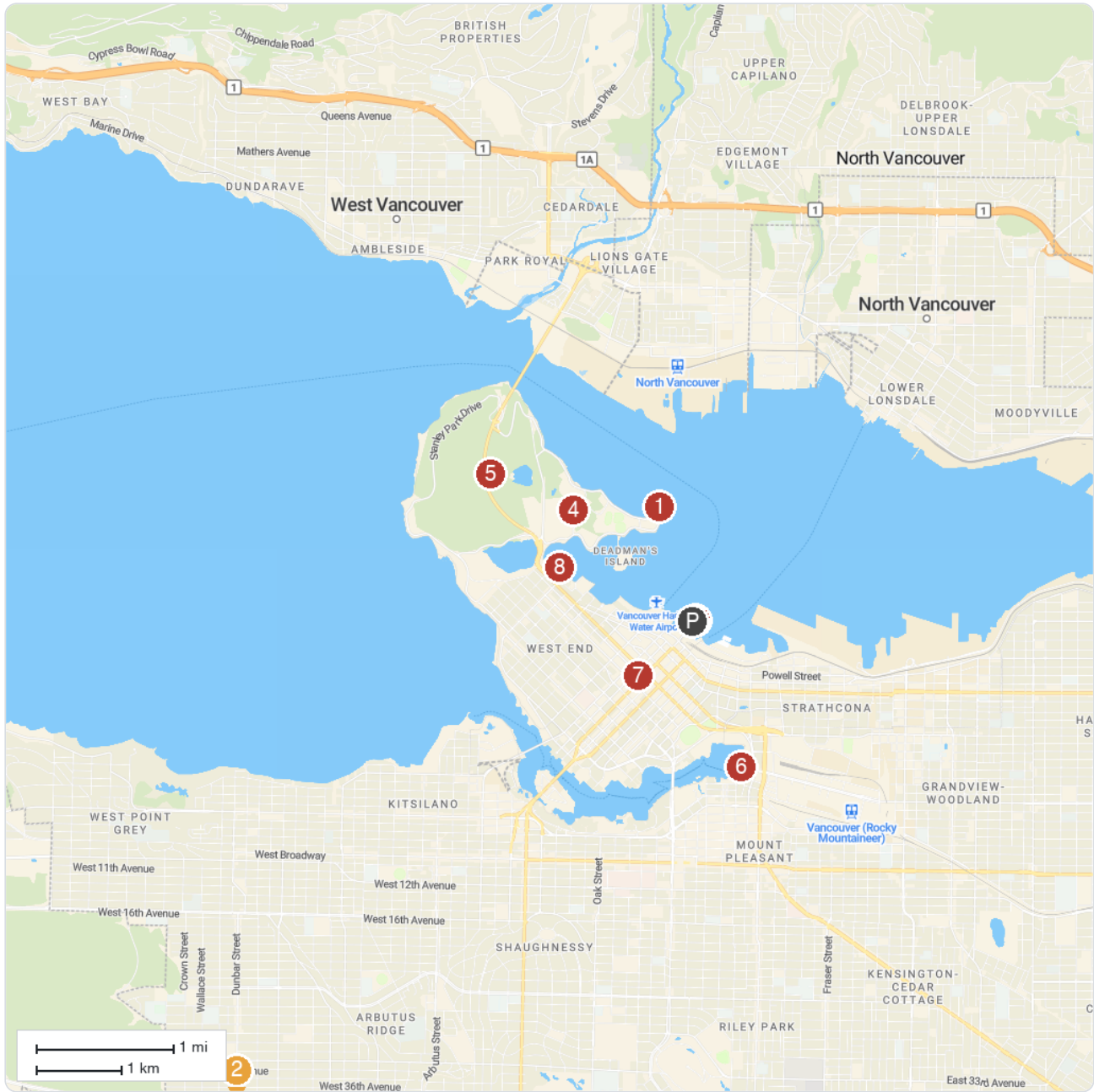
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
