GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River berth alongside quay; ships dock in the town center

Walk to center: 5 min stroll from dock to Vernon's historic core

Best For: Monet's Giverny gardens, Impressionist art, Norman architecture

Don't Miss: The Old Mill (Vieux-Moulin) straddling the medieval bridge on the Seine

Getting around: **Taxi** ~€15–20 one-way to Giverny

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Monet's House & Gardens, Giverny** — Walk through the Clos Normand flower garden and the famous Japanese-bridge Water Garden that inspired Monet's Water...
- **Museum of Impressionism, Giverny** — A world-class museum devoted to the Impressionist movement and the American artists who flocked to Giverny in Monet's...
- **Château Gaillard & Les Andelys** — Richard the Lionheart's dramatic cliff-top castle towers above the Seine just 30 km upriver.
- **Rouen — Gothic City on the Seine** — Joan of Arc's city and home to one of France's finest Gothic cathedrals — the same façade Monet painted 30 times.
- **Seine Valley Bike Ride** — Rent a bicycle near Vernon station and pedal the flat greenway to Giverny along the Seine — a 5 km scenic ride through...

BEST WALKS

- **Vernon Old Town & Seine Waterfront** 1.5 km · ~45 min · Easy — From the quay, walk along the riverfront to the iconic Vieux-Moulin (Old Mill) on the medieval bridge piers, then loop through the...
- **Bike or Walk to Giverny** 5 km one way · ~25 min by bike · Flat — A dedicated cycle/walking path traces the Seine valley from Vernon's train station area straight to Giverny village.

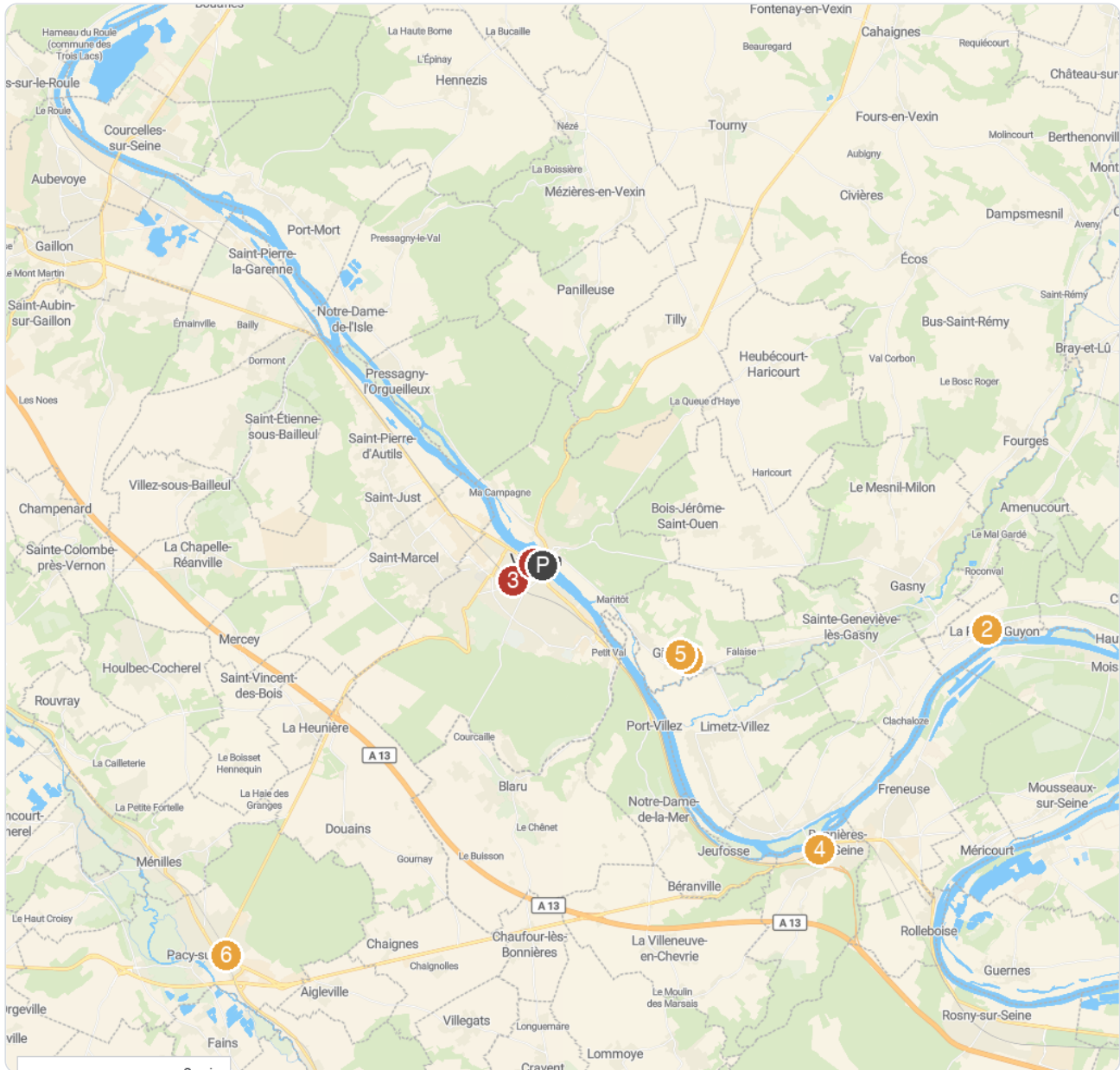
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
