The Smoke That Thunders. One of the seven natural wonders of the world, Victoria Falls is not a dockside port — it's a fly-in crown jewel that world cruises access as a land extension from Cape Town or Durban. The payoff: a full day (or more) at one of Africa's most spectacular destinations.

GETTING ASHORE

Arrival: Fly into Victoria Falls Airport (VFA) or Livingstone (LVI) — no cruise pier exists

Don't Miss: Devil's Cataract viewpoint and a sunset cruise on the Upper Zambezi

Best For: Waterfall walks, helicopter rides, Zambezi cruises, white-water rafting, safari

Entry Fee: USD \$58 Zimbabwe side; USD \$20 Zambia side (Victoria Falls National Park)

Getting around: **Taxi** USD 5–12

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Victoria Falls National Park Walk** — Sixteen viewpoints along the Zimbabwean rim — from Cataract View to Danger Point — reveal the full 1,708-metre curtain...
- Flight of Angels — Helicopter Tour** — A 12–25 minute helicopter flight over the falls and Batoka Gorge.
- Zambezi Sunset Cruise** — A two-hour float on the Upper Zambezi (upstream from the falls) with hippos wallowing close to the boat, elephants at...
- White-Water Rafting — Batoka Gorge** — The Zambezi below the falls is consistently rated one of the top one-day rafting runs in the world, with Grade 5 rapids...
- Chobe National Park Day Safari** — A 90-minute drive into Botswana reaches Chobe, famous for Africa's densest elephant population.

BEST WALKS

- Victoria Falls Rainforest Trail** 2–3 km | Easy | Wet — bring rain gear — Follow the paved path from the National Park entrance past all 16 viewpoints: Cataract View, Main Falls, Horseshoe, Rainbow Falls, and...
- Victoria Falls Town Stroll** 1–2 km | Easy | Safe during daylight — From most hotels it's a short flat walk down Livingstone Way to the park gate, passing the landmark Victoria Falls Hotel (stop for...

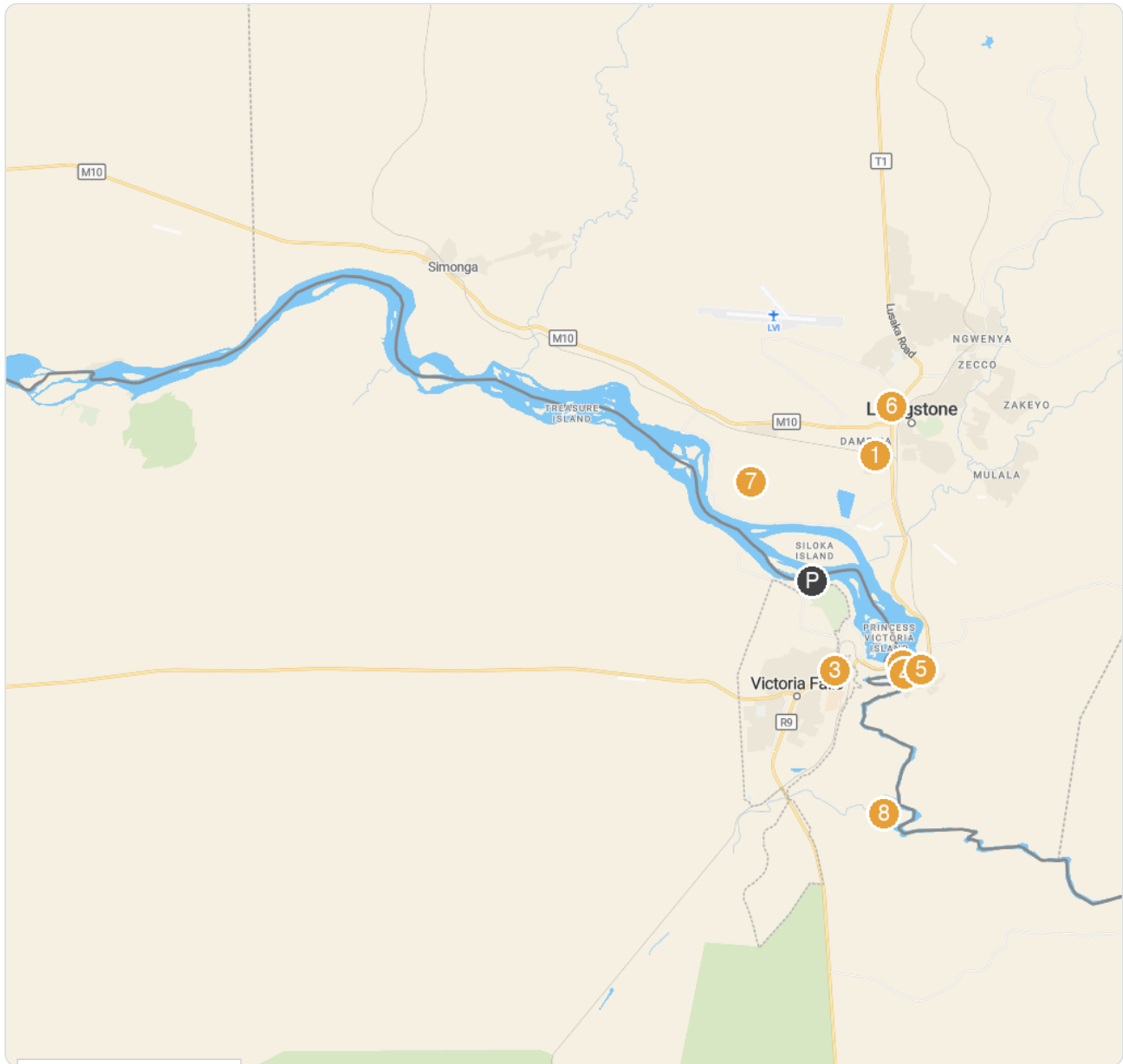
