TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Roman Vienne Highlights** — Walk the Temple of Augustus and Livia (one of the best-preserved Roman temples in existence), the Ancient Theatre...
- **Saint-Romain-en-Gal Museum & Site** — Cross the pedestrian footbridge to the right bank and explore one of France's largest archaeological sites — excavated...
- **Côte-Rôtie & Condrieu Wine Tasting** — Vienne sits at the northern gateway of the Rhône wine region.
- **Saturday Grand Market** — One of the largest outdoor markets in France — over 5 km of stalls winding through the city on Saturday mornings.
- **Mount Pipet Viewpoint** — Climb (or take the tourist train) to the belvedere above the Roman theatre for panoramic views over Vienne's rooftops...

BEST WALKS

- **Roman Heart of Vienne** 1.5 km · ~30 min · Easy (flat, then optional uphill) — From the riverfront, walk to Place du Palais to admire the Temple of Augustus, then continue to the Cathedral of Saint-Maurice, the...
- **Cross the Rhône to Saint-Romain-en-Gal** ~1 km each way · 20 min · Easy — Head north along the embankment and cross the Passerelle de Saint-Romain-en-Gal pedestrian suspension bridge to the right bank.

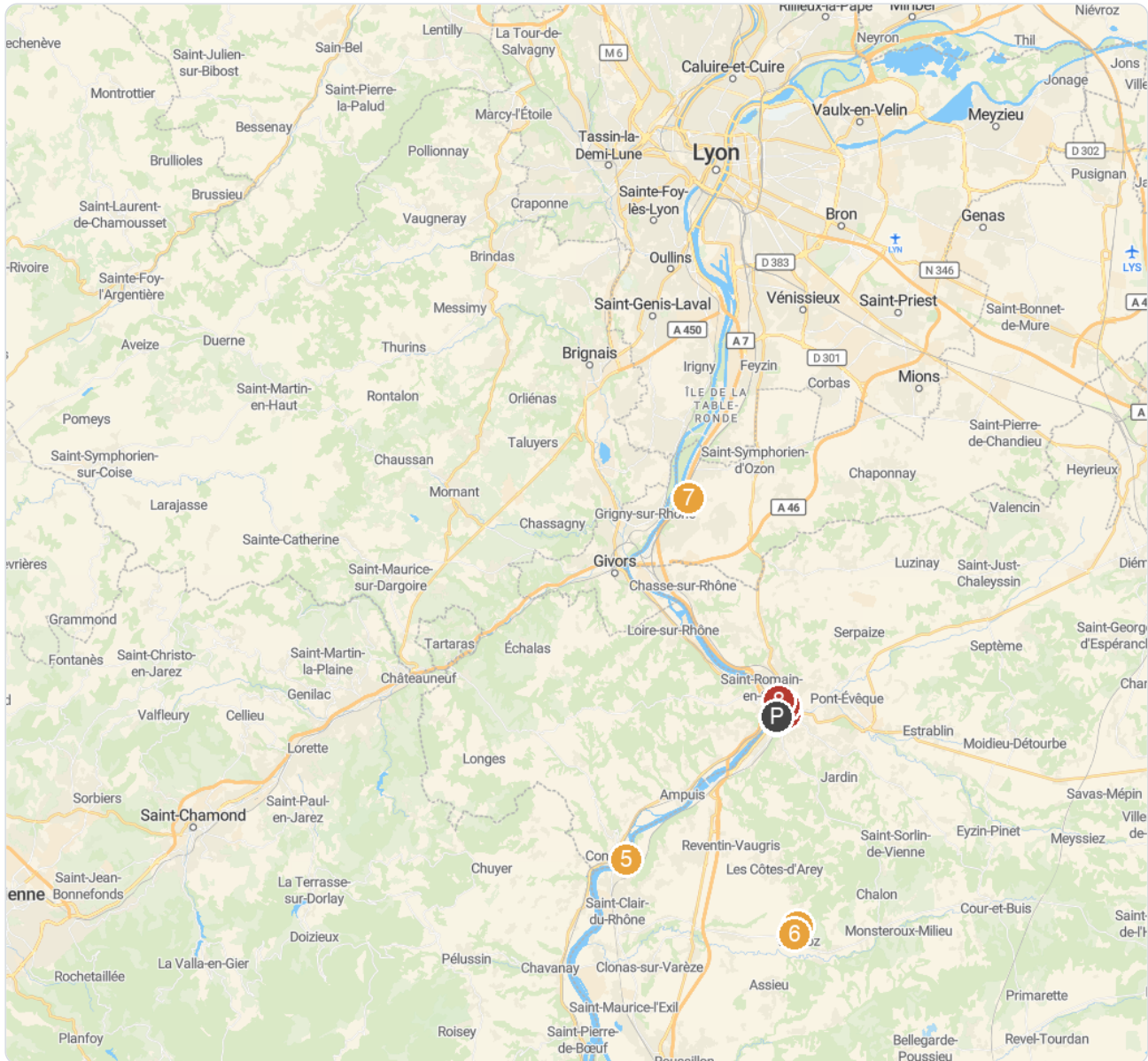
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
