Docking: Pier — Muelle de Transatlanticos, city center waterfront

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Cíes Islands National Park** — Ferry to the Atlantic Islands National Park — white-sand Rodas Beach, turquoise water, and wild dunes in a protected...
- Castillo del Castro & Old Town Walk** — Climb (or escalate) to Vigo's 17th-century hilltop fortress for sweeping views of the ría, then wind through the...
- Galician Seafood & Oyster Street** — Rúa da Pescadería in the Old Town is lined with stalls where vendors shuck fresh local oysters right in front of you.
- Samil Beach** — Vigo's main city beach — a wide arc of fine white sand with a long promenade, cafés, and sports facilities.
- Pazo de Castrelos & Gardens** — A 17th-century manor house turned municipal museum, surrounded by formal English and French gardens.

BEST WALKS

- Old Town & Castro Castle Loop** 3-4 km · 2-2.5 hrs · Moderate (uphill sections) — From the cruise terminal, cross into the Casco Vello, browse Rúa da Pescadería (oyster street), pass through Plaza de la Constitución...
- Harbor Promenade & Jules Verne Statue** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy (flat) — A simple waterfront stroll south from the cruise terminal along the Paseo de Alfonso XII to the Jules Verne statue and the old olive...

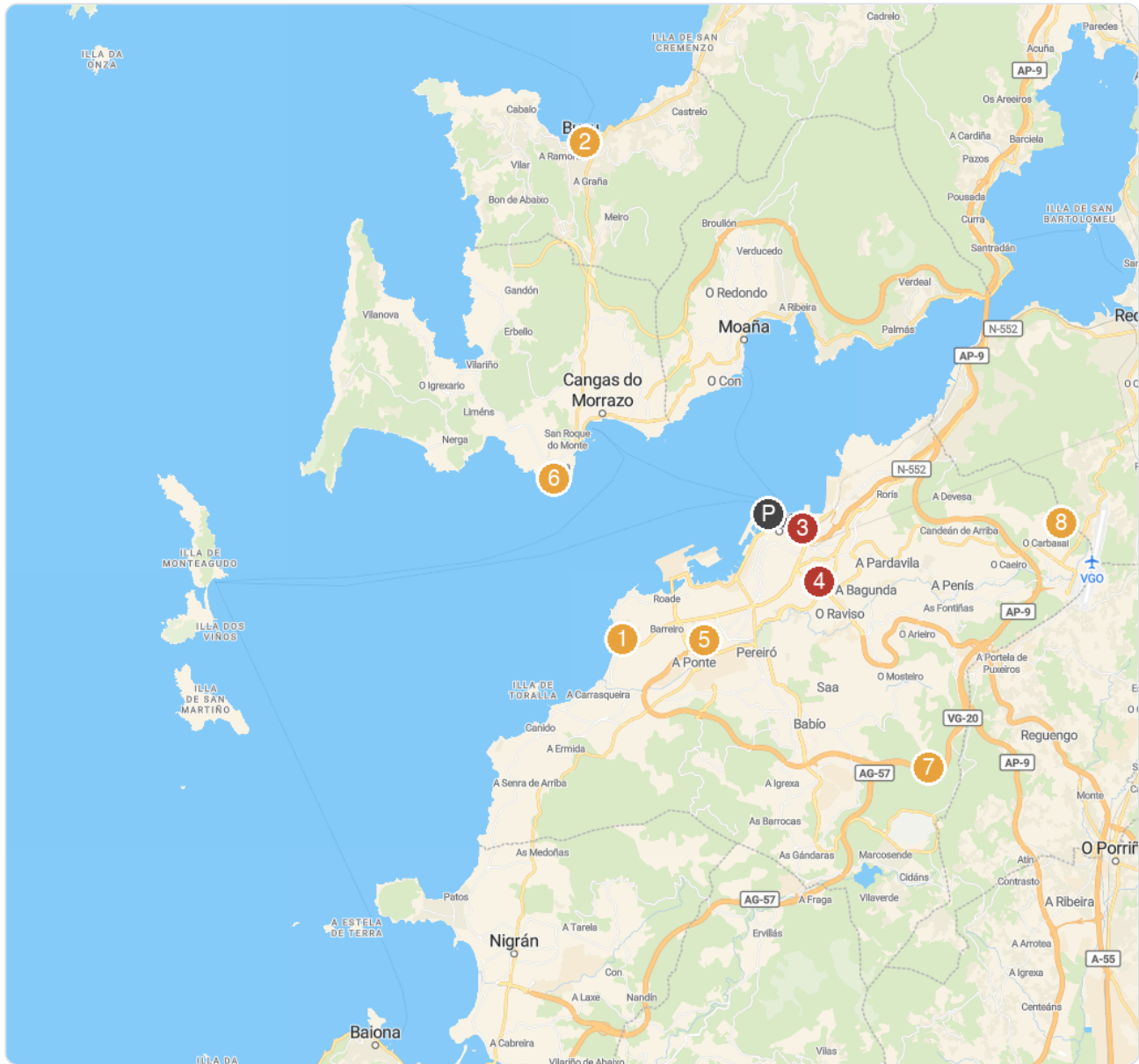
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
