GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender for mid/large ships; small yachts & coastal cruisers dock at Vis Town pier

Best For: Blue Cave excursion, WWII history, authentic Dalmatian food, unspoiled beaches

Walk to center: Immediate — you step ashore in Vis Town; Kut old quarter is 15-20 min walk

Don't Miss: Blue Cave on Biševo Island, Kut old quarter, Tito's cave military tour

Getting around: Taxi €5 start + €2.30/km (car); €3.10/km (van) · Rideshare not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Blue Cave (Biševo Island)** — Sunlight enters an underwater opening and reflects off the white limestone floor, flooding the cave in electric blue...
- WWII & Cold-War Military Tour** — A 4x4 guide takes you into classified Yugoslav-era bunkers, underground rocket bases, and Tito's Cave — a clifftop...
- Stiniva Cove by Boat** — Europe's best beach 2016 — a narrow cliff passage opens to a hidden white-pebble cove surrounded by towering rock walls.
- Vis Town & Kut Old Quarter Walk** — Kut is one of Dalmatia's most atmospheric neighborhoods — Venetian Renaissance palaces, stone alleys, and hidden...
- Vis Wine & Seafood Lunch** — Vis grows Vugava, a golden, full-bodied white wine cultivated since ancient Greek settlers arrived.

BEST WALKS

- Quay to Kut Old Quarter** 15-20 min one way | Flat | Free — From the tender quay at Luka, walk east along the seafront promenade past cafes and fishing boats to the Kut neighborhood.
- Quay to Prirovo Beach & Monastery** 10 min one way | Flat | Free — Walk west from the quay along the harbor road to the small Prirovo Peninsula.
- Fort George Hike** 30 min up | Moderate | Free — From Kut, follow the road uphill to the British-built Fort George (1813, Napoleonic era).

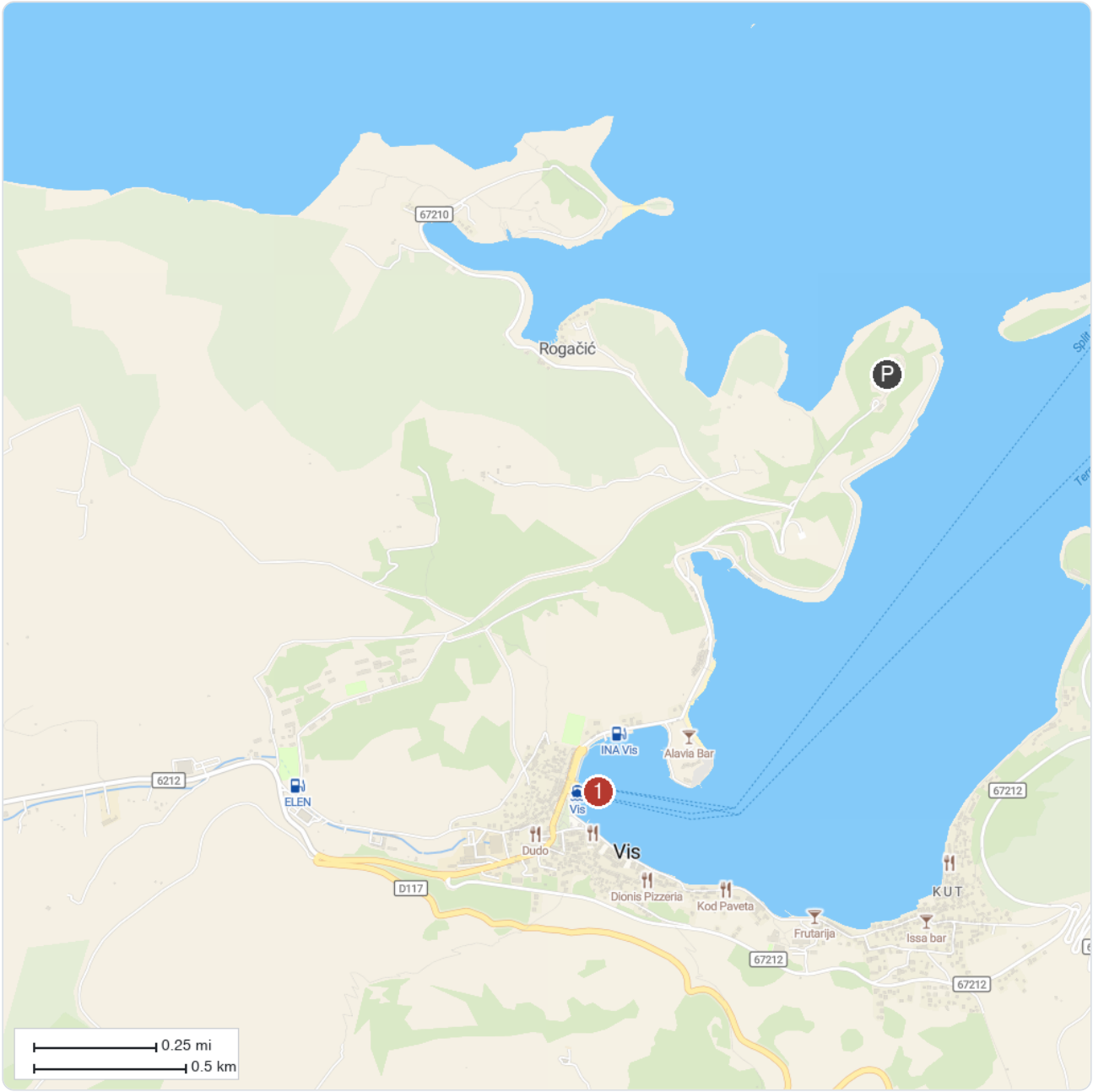
