GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Floating pontoon pier, steps from the Baroque city center

Best For: Modern history, Vučedol archaeology, regional wine & food

Walk to center: 2–5 min to pedestrian zone; 20 min to Water Tower

Don't Miss: Vukovar Water Tower — 600+ shell hits and still standing

Getting around: **Taxi** €3–€6 · **Rideshare** Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Vukovar Water Tower** — The defining symbol of the 1991 siege: a 50-metre tower struck by 600+ shells that refused to fall.
 - Eltz Manor & Municipal Museum** — An 18th-century Baroque palace meticulously restored after war damage.
 - Vučedol Culture Museum** — A stunning modern museum ~5 km from the dock dedicated to a 5,000-year-old culture
- famous for the Vučedol Dove — the...

 - Slavonian Food & Wine Tasting** — Try fiš paprikaš (spicy river-fish stew), kulen cured sausage, and local Graševina white wine.
 - Memorial Cemetery of Homeland War Victims** — The largest mass grave in Europe since WWII — 938 white marble crosses for victims exhumed here.

BEST WALKS

- Danube Promenade to Baroque City Center** 45 min · Flat · Free — Walk from the pontoon pier along the Danube Promenade, turn into the pedestrian main street (Ulica dr.
- Promenade to Water Tower** 40 min each way · Flat · ~€10–13 entry — A pleasant 2 km walk from the dock along the riverbank to the war-damaged water tower.

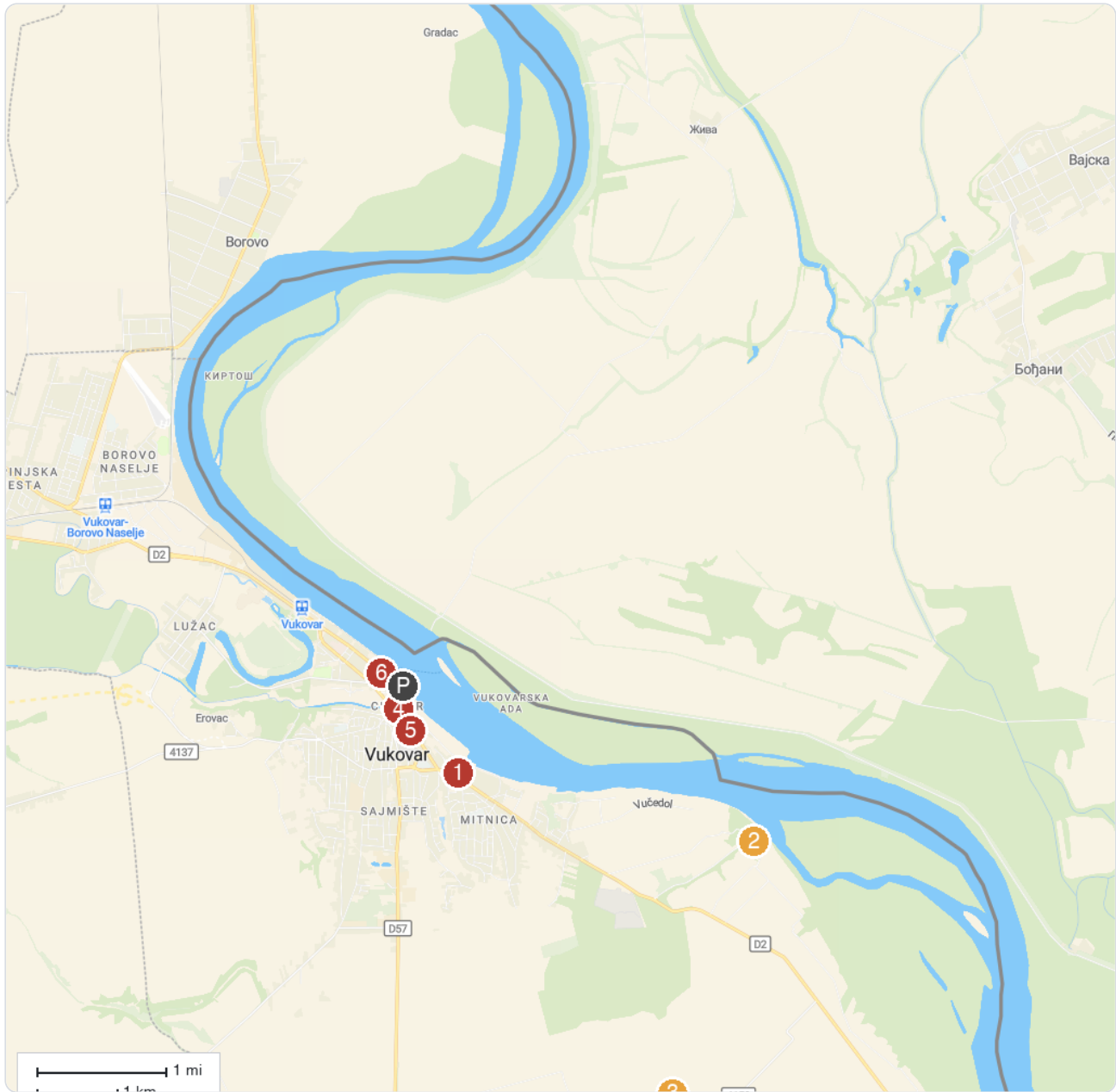
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euros everywhere. Croatia switched to the Euro in 2023. Cards accepted at museums and restaurants; keep a little cash for taxi boats and small cafes.
- Respect the wounds. Many buildings still bear bullet holes — they're preserved deliberately. Treat war memorials with quiet

- 1 Vukovar Water Tower** This iconic water tower is a powerful symbol of Vukovar's resilience.
- 3 Ovcara Memorial Center** A solemn memorial honoring victims of the tragic Vukovar massacre.
- 5 Crucifix** A poignant crucifix memorializing victims of the Homeland War.
- P Cruise port / terminal**

- 2 Vučedol Culture Museum and Archaeological Site** Explore ancient Vučedol culture at this significant archaeological site and museum.
- 4 Radnički dom / Grand hotel** Historic Radnički dom, once Grand Hotel, now a cultural hub.
- 6 Vukovar Municipal Museum / Castle Eltz** Discover Vukovar's history within the beautiful Eltz Castle museum.
