GETTING ASHORE

Docking: CentrePort Aotea Quay (larger ships) or Queens Wharf (smaller ships); shuttle to city centre

Best For: Museums, culture, wildlife, café-hopping, Lord of the Rings fans

Walk to Centre: ~10 min shuttle or 20 min walk from Queens Wharf; walking from Aotea Quay not permitted

Don't Miss: Te Papa Tongarewa, Wellington Cable Car & Botanic Garden

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Te Papa Tongarewa National Museum** — New Zealand's flagship national museum is a short shuttle ride from the port and free to enter.
- **Wellington Cable Car & Botanic Garden** — Ride the historic red cable car from Lambton Quay up to Kelburn for panoramic harbour views, then stroll downhill...
- **Zealandia Ecosanctuary** — A predator-fenced urban wildlife sanctuary just 2 km from the city centre, home to kiwi, tuatara, kākā parrots, and...
- **Weta Workshop Unleashed** — Go behind the scenes at the world-famous special-effects studio responsible for Lord of the Rings, Avatar, and more.
- **Seal Coast Safari** — A 4WD safari along Wellington's rugged south coast to see New Zealand fur seals on the rocks at Red Rocks Reserve.

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Cuba Street** 2-3 km · 45-60 min · Flat · Easy — Start at the Te Papa waterfront, stroll north past Frank Kitts Park and Civic Square, then cut west up Manners Street to Cuba Street...
- **Mount Victoria Lookout** 3 km loop · 60-90 min · Moderate hills · Great views — From the city centre, follow the signs up to the summit of Mount Victoria (196 m) for 360° views of Wellington Harbour, the Remutaka...
- **Heritage Cable Car Walk** 3 km one-way · 90 min · Downhill · Easy — Take the cable car from Lambton Quay to Kelburn, explore the Botanic Garden, then walk downhill through Thorndon past Old St Paul's...

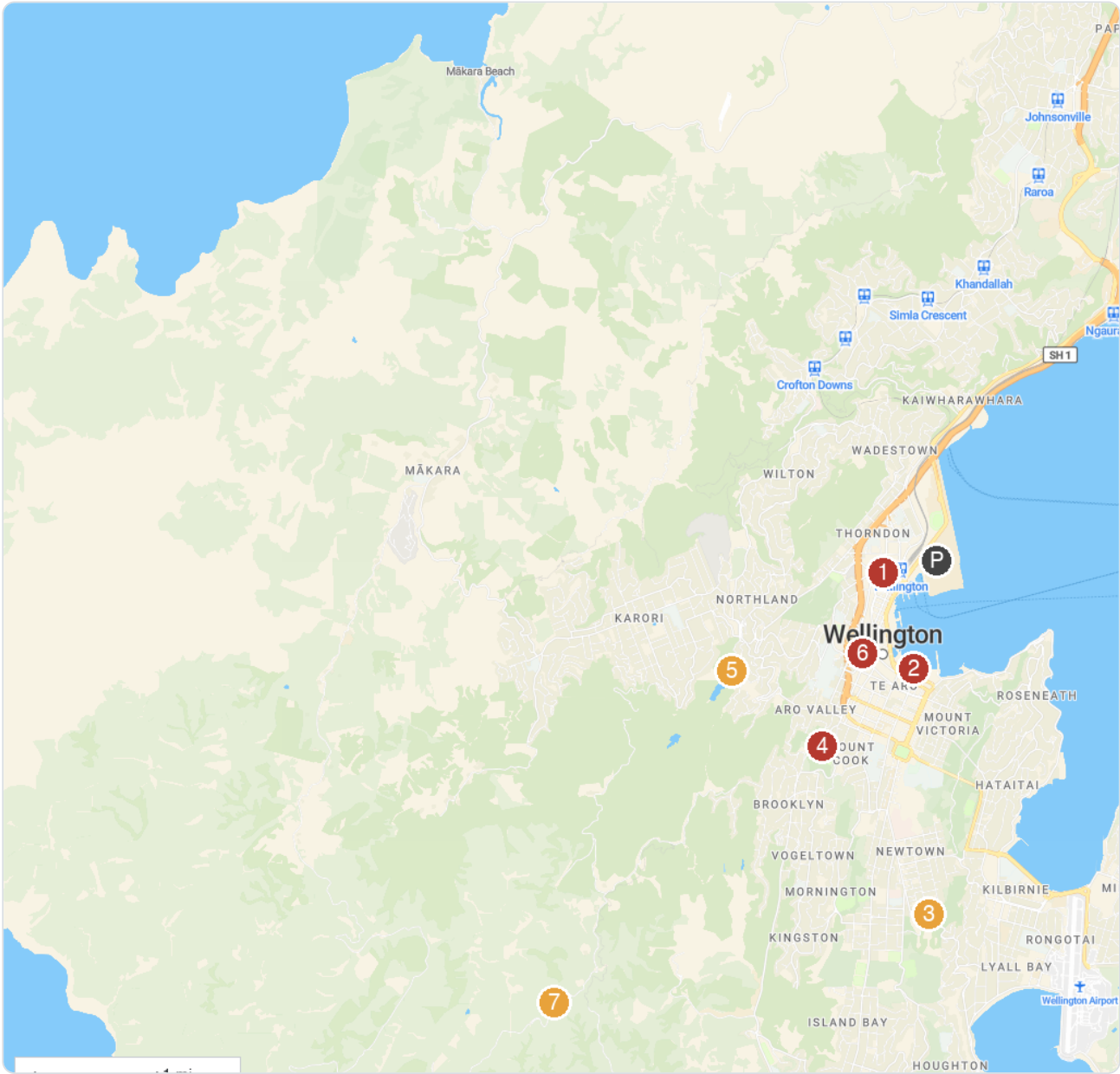
