GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked at city docks along the downtown Riverwalk; small/expedition ships only — bridge height limits large vessels

Best For: History lovers, WWII buffs, Southern dining, strolling a beautiful riverside downtown

Walk to center: Steps from the dock — the Riverwalk and Historic Downtown are immediately adjacent

Don't Miss: Battleship North Carolina — the most battle-decorated US battleship of WWII, moored just across the river

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Battleship North Carolina** — The most decorated US battleship of World War II is permanently moored just across the Cape Fear River.
- **Historic Downtown Walking Tour** — Wilmington's 230-block historic district is one of the largest in the South.
- **Wrightsville Beach Day** — One of the best beaches on the East Coast is just 15 minutes away.
- **Cape Fear River Cruise** — Board a narrated riverboat with Cape Fear Riverboats for an ecological and historical tour of the river, with views of...
- **Cape Fear Museum** — A well-curated regional museum covering the natural and human history of the Cape Fear area — including a surprising...

BEST WALKS

- **Cape Fear Riverwalk Stroll** ~2 miles one-way | Easy | 45-60 min — Walk the full length of the Riverwalk from the northern docks (near the Isabel Holmes Bridge) south to Chandler's Wharf.
- **Historic Downtown Loop** ~1.5 miles | Easy | 45-60 min — From the Riverwalk head east into the historic district.

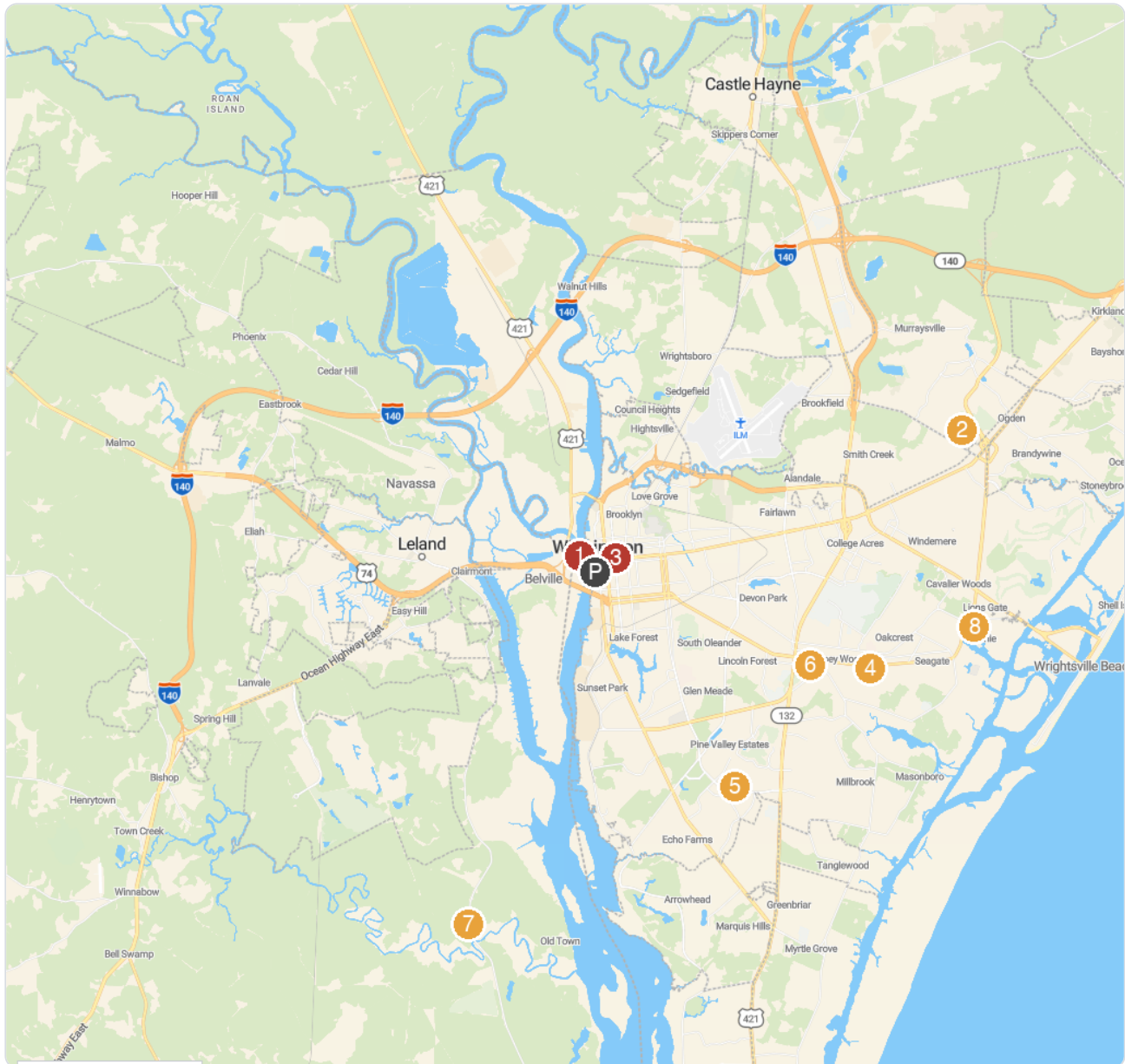
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Small-ship port only. Wilmington's city docks accommodate river cruise vessels and small expedition ships. Large ocean liners cannot call here due to the Cape Fear Memorial Bridge...
- Battleship North Carolina is across the river — a short drive or rideshare over the bridge, or take the water taxi from the Riverwalk when available. Budget at least 2 hours.
