Docking: Osanbashi or Shinko pier — no tender required

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Yokohama Chinatown & Yamashita Park** — Japan's largest Chinatown is a 10-minute walk from Osanbashi — 600+ restaurants and shops packed into a few vivid blocks.
- **Minato Mirai & Landmark Tower** — The futuristic Minato Mirai waterfront district clusters the 296m Landmark Tower (Sky Garden observation deck on floor...)
- **Day Trip to Kamakura** — The Great Buddha of Kotoku-in stands 13.35 m tall in the open air — one of Japan's most iconic images.
- **Tokyo Day Trip** — Shibuya Crossing, Asakusa's Senso-ji temple, Meiji Shrine, and Ginza shopping — Tokyo is 30-45 minutes by direct train.
- **Hakone & Mount Fuji Views** — On a clear day, Hakone's open-air museum, Lake Ashi ropeway, and Fuji views make a spectacular excursion.

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront Promenade: Osanbashi to Minato Mirai** ~3 km | 45-60 min | Flat & easy — Leave Osanbashi terminal and walk west along the harbor past Yamashita Park, through the Shinko Pier area, past the Red Brick...
- **Chinatown & Motomachi Stroll** ~2 km loop | 1-2 hrs | Easy — From Osanbashi, head inland 10 minutes to Yokohama Chinatown — Japan's largest, with 600+ eateries.

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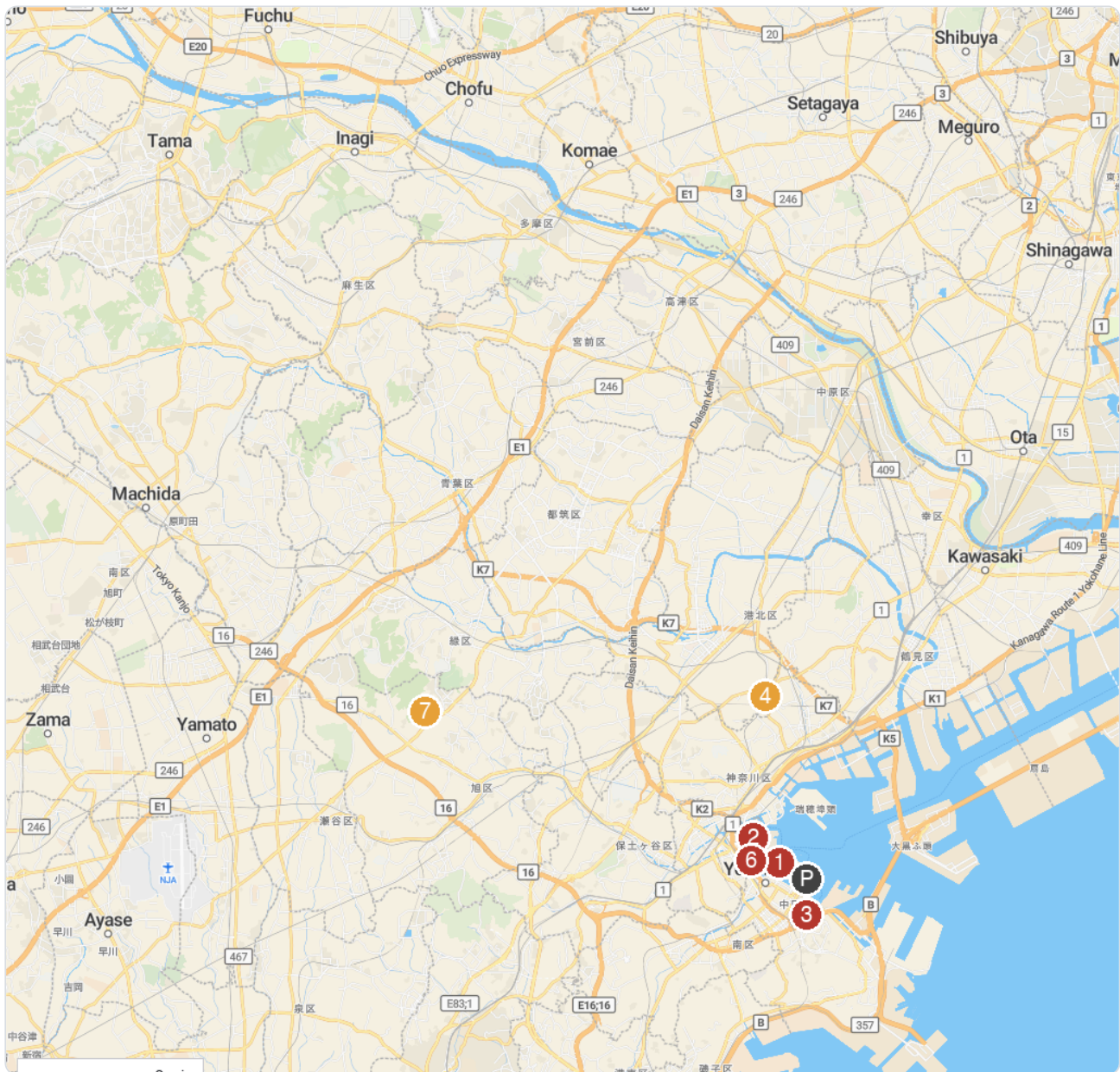
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
