GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the bay; boats transfer to the town harbor pier

Best For: Boat excursions to Navagio & Blue Caves, sea-turtle spotting, Venetian architecture

Walk to center: 1-2 min from tender pier to Solomos Square

Don't Miss: Cliffside viewpoint over Shipwreck Beach (Navagio) — 50-60 min drive each way

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Navagio Shipwreck Bay & Blue Caves Boat Tour** — The signature excursion: a boat trip to the stunning Navagio Bay to view the rusting MV Panagiotis shipwreck from the...
- Sea Turtle Spotting — Marathonisi (Turtle Island)** — Head to Laganas Bay in the south, the most important Loggerhead sea turtle nesting area in the Mediterranean.
- Zakynthos Town & Byzantine Museum** — Explore the arcaded Venetian streets of Zakynthos Town, visit the ornate Church of Agios Dionysios (resting place of...
- Navagio Cliffside Viewpoint Drive** — Drive or taxi to the dramatic cliffs on the northwest tip of the island for the famous panoramic shot of Navagio Beach...
- Tsilivi Beach Day** — A long sandy beach 10-15 minutes north of the port by taxi (about €12-15 each way).

BEST WALKS

- Zakynthos Town Harborfront & Solomos Square** 30-45 min · Easy · Free — From the tender pier, stroll along the harbor promenade to Solomos Square, browse Alexandrou Roma pedestrian street, and visit the...
- Bochali Hill Viewpoint** 25-30 min uphill walk (or €7-10 taxi) · Moderate · Free — Climb (or taxi) to Bochali Hill above Zakynthos Town for sweeping views of the harbor, your cruise ship at anchor, and the Peloponnese...

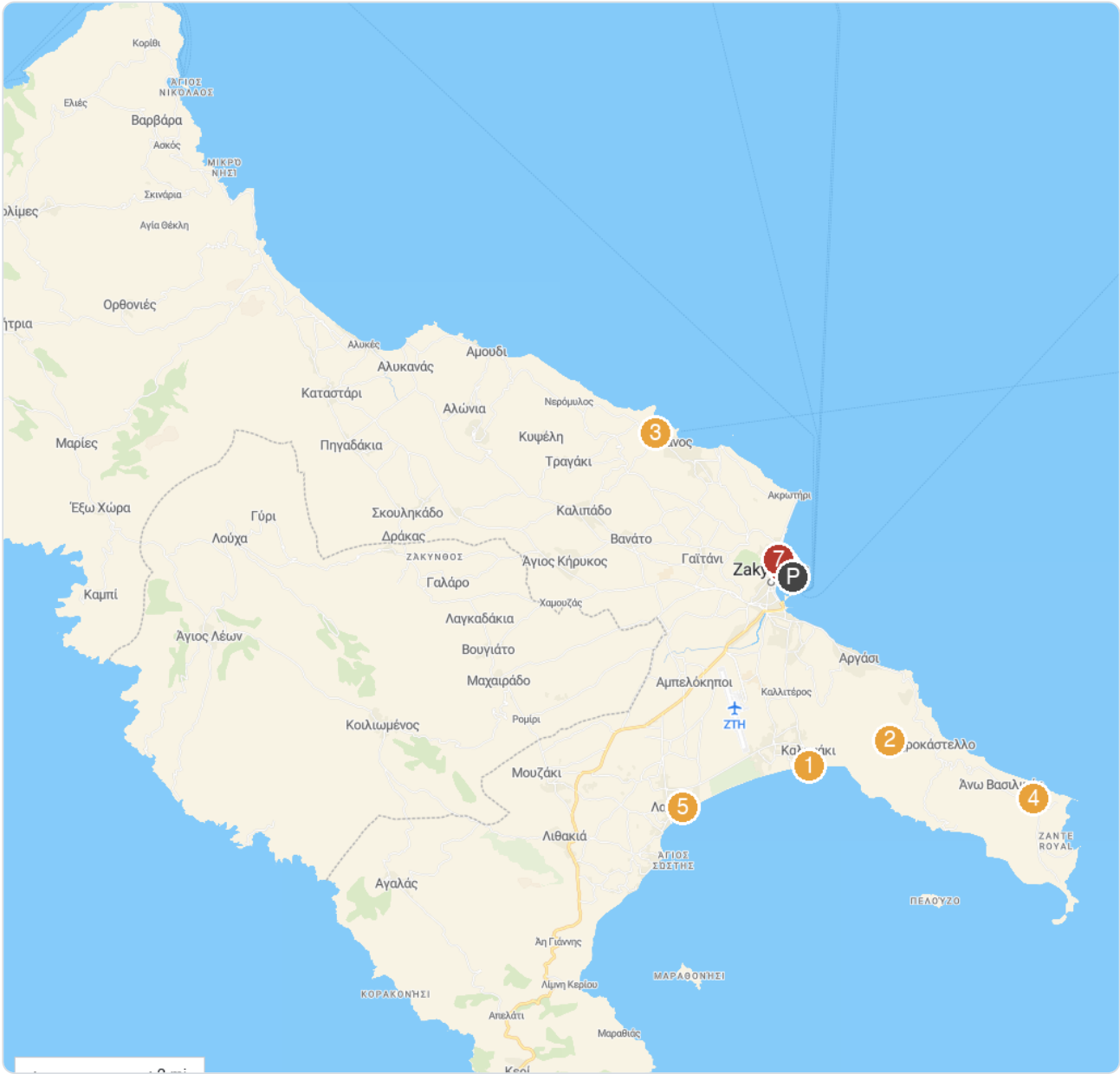
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
